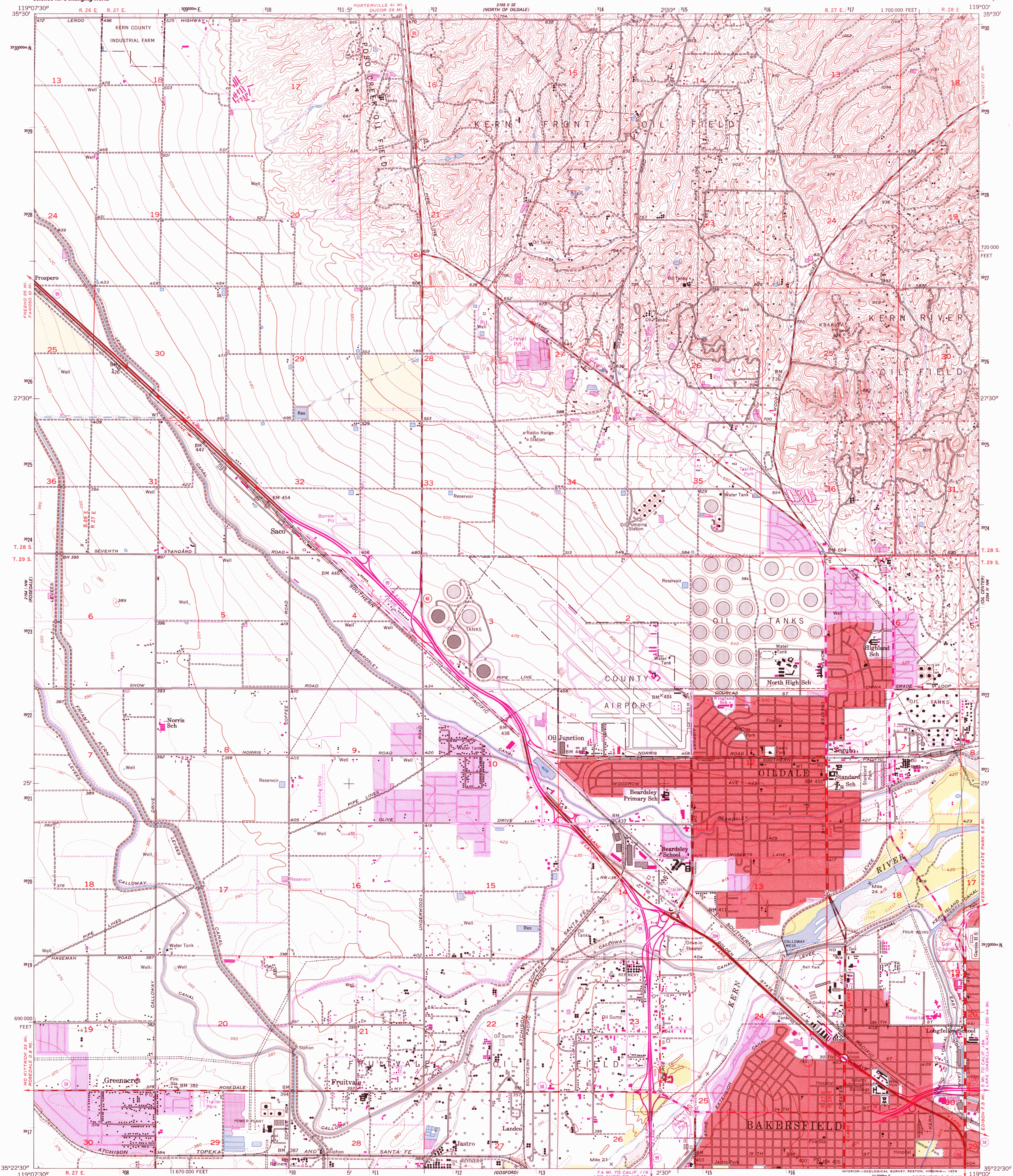

Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown

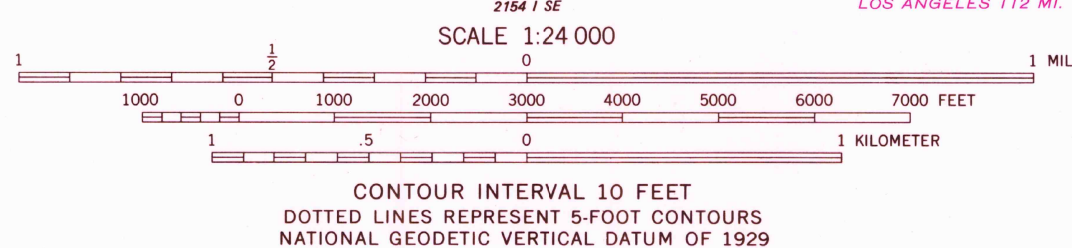
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 11, shown in blue
