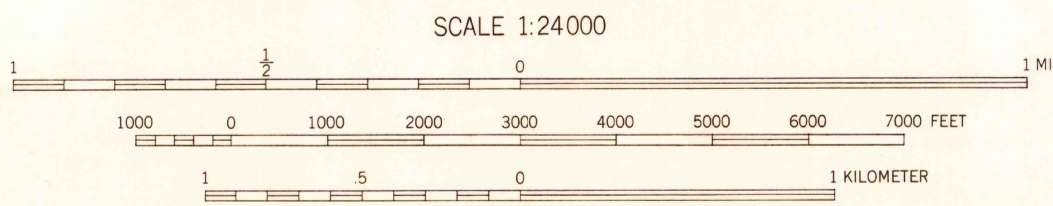
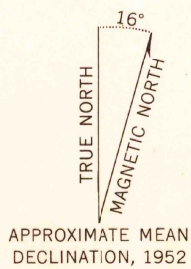

Unchecked elevations are shown in brown

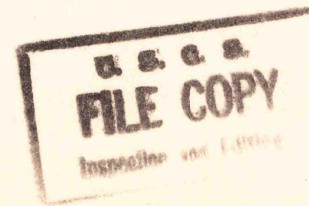


CONTOUR INTERVAL 40 FEET
