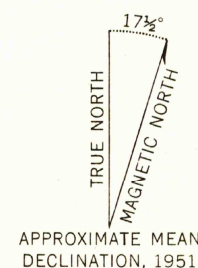

completion of Lower Bear River Reservoir

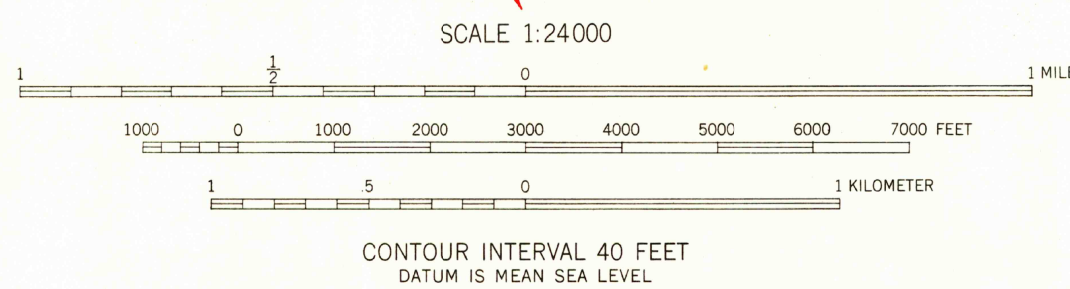
