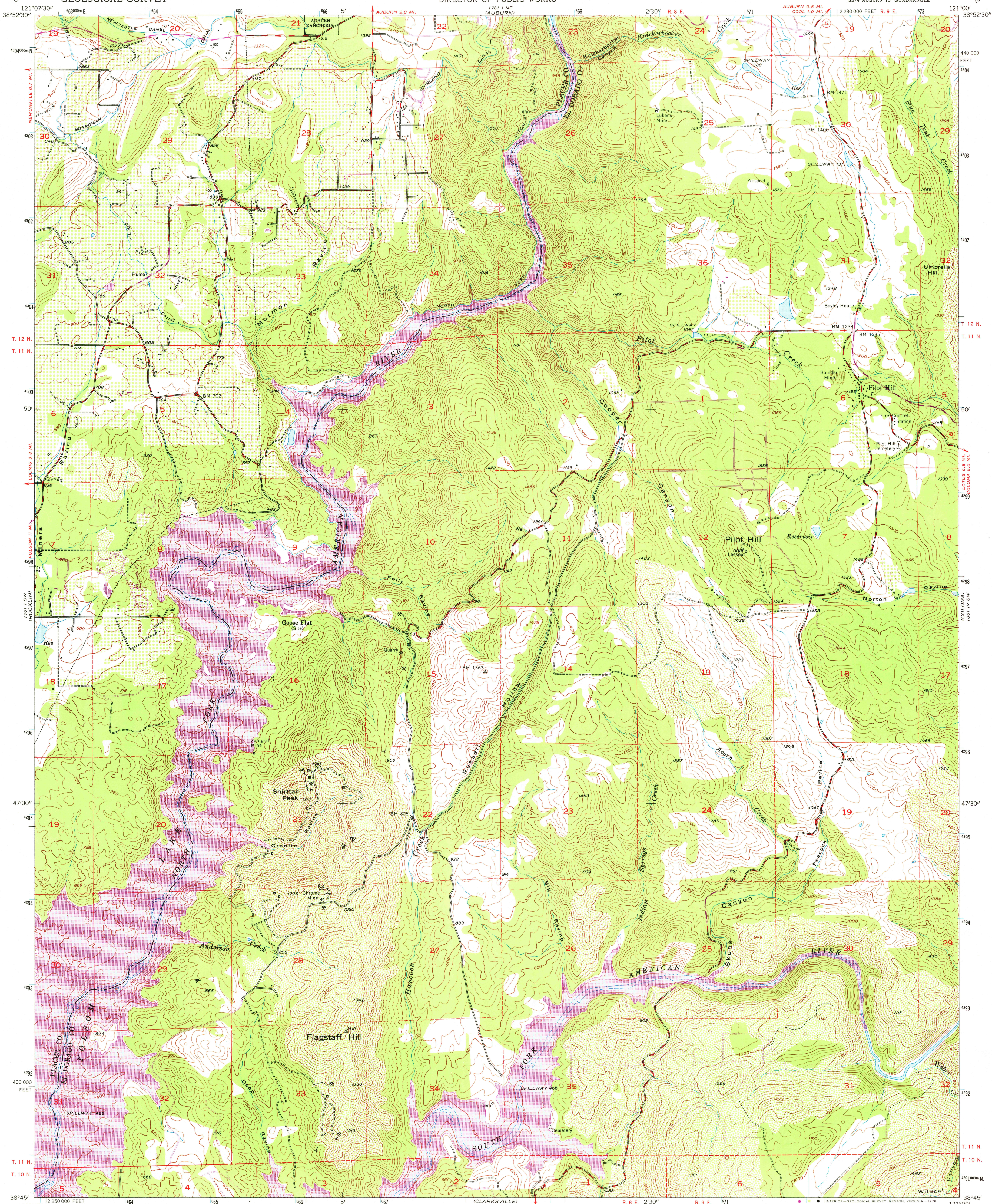

10,000-foot grid based on California coordinate system, zone 2

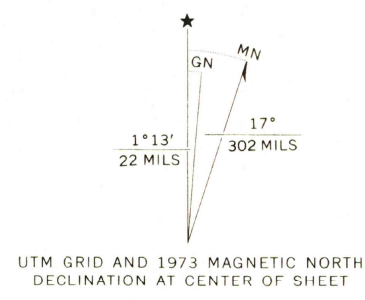
Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,

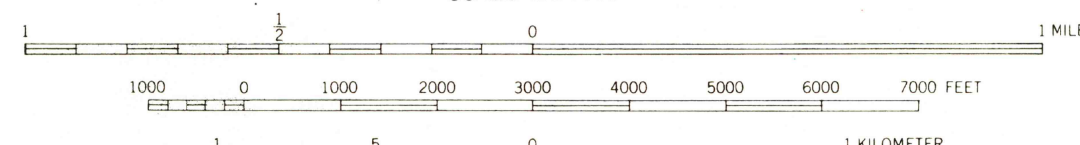
