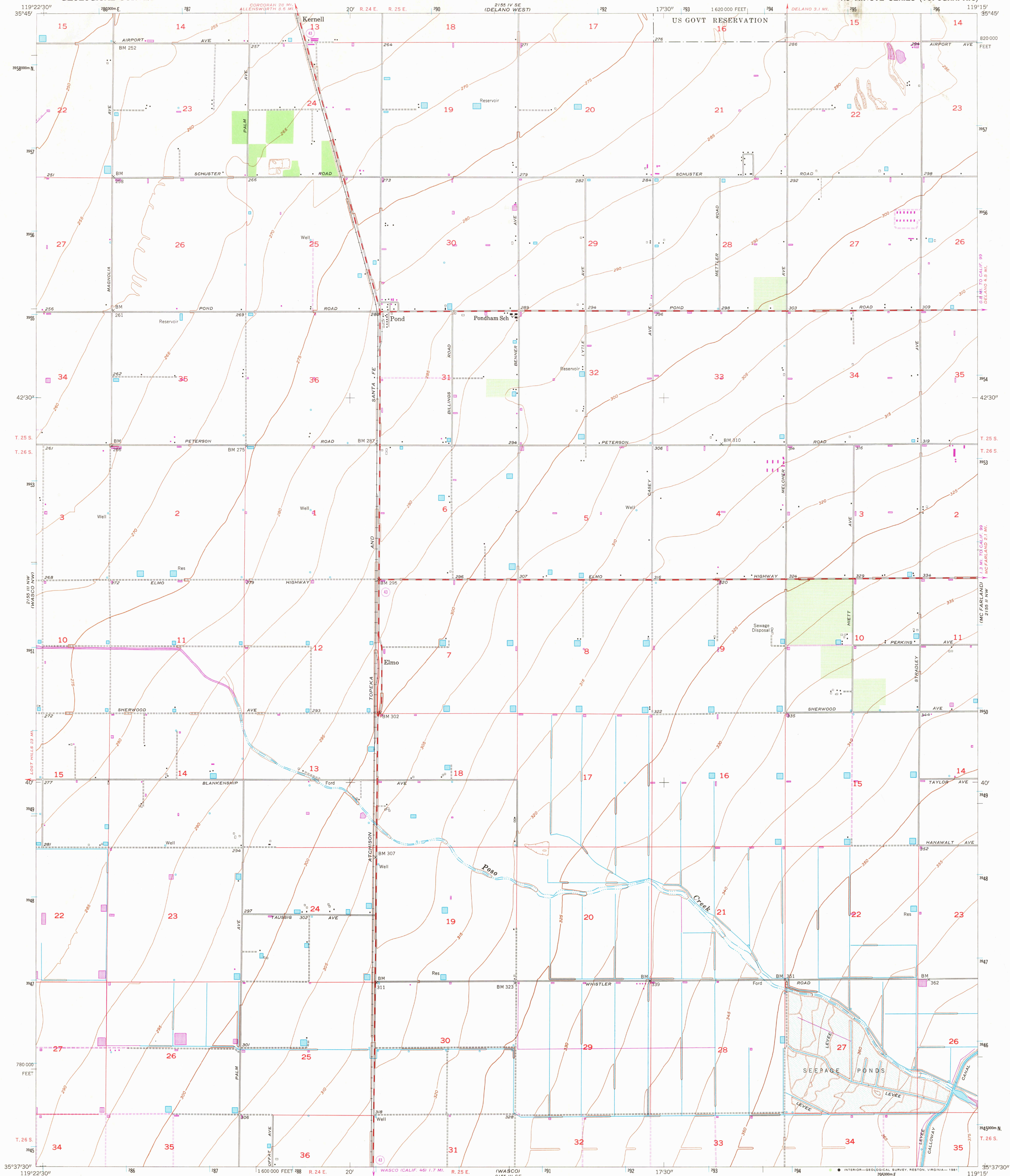

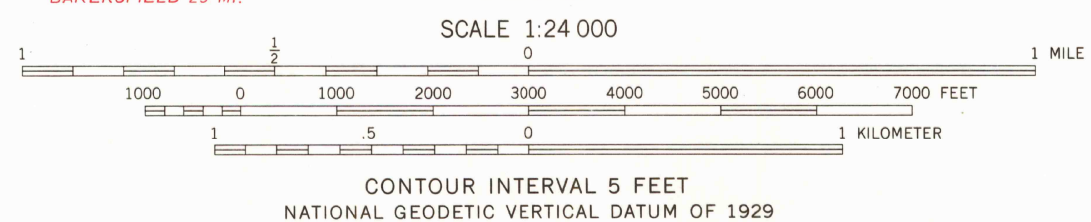
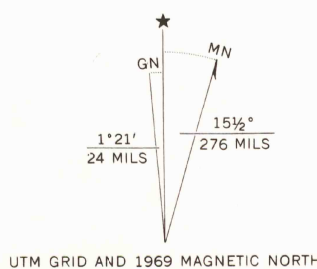
Culture and drainage compiled from aerial photographs taken 1946. Topography by plane-table methods 1953
