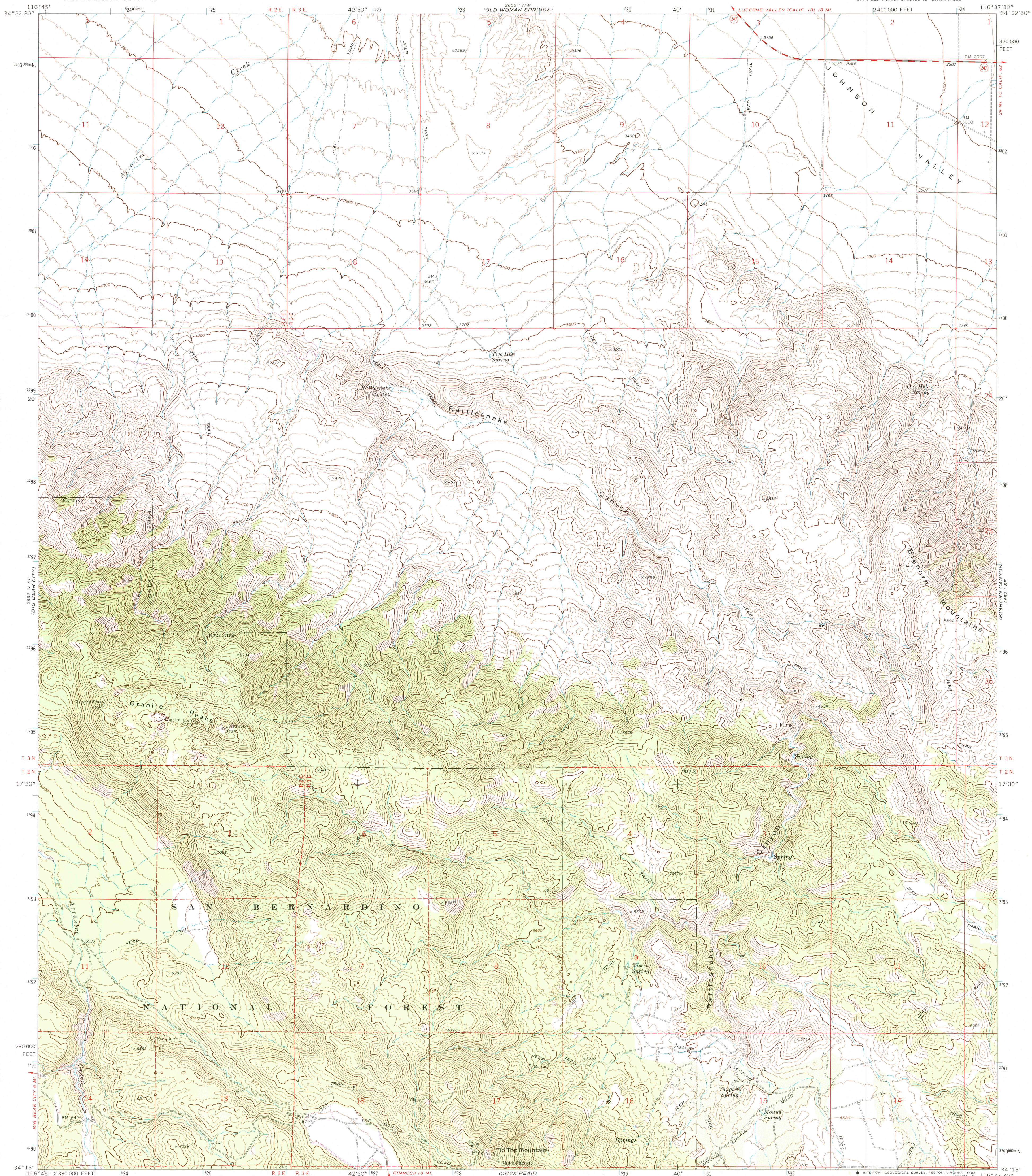

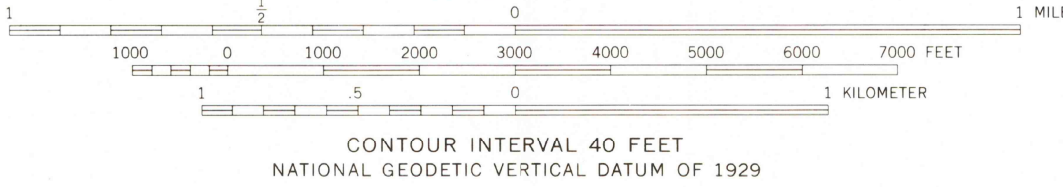
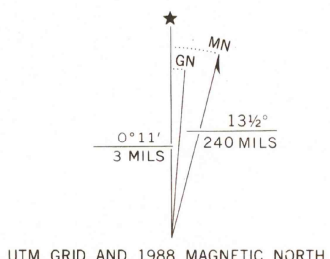
1000-metre Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,

move the projection lines 2 meters north and

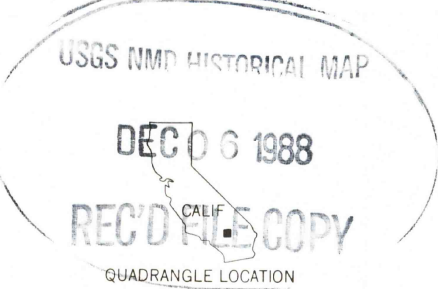
81 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
