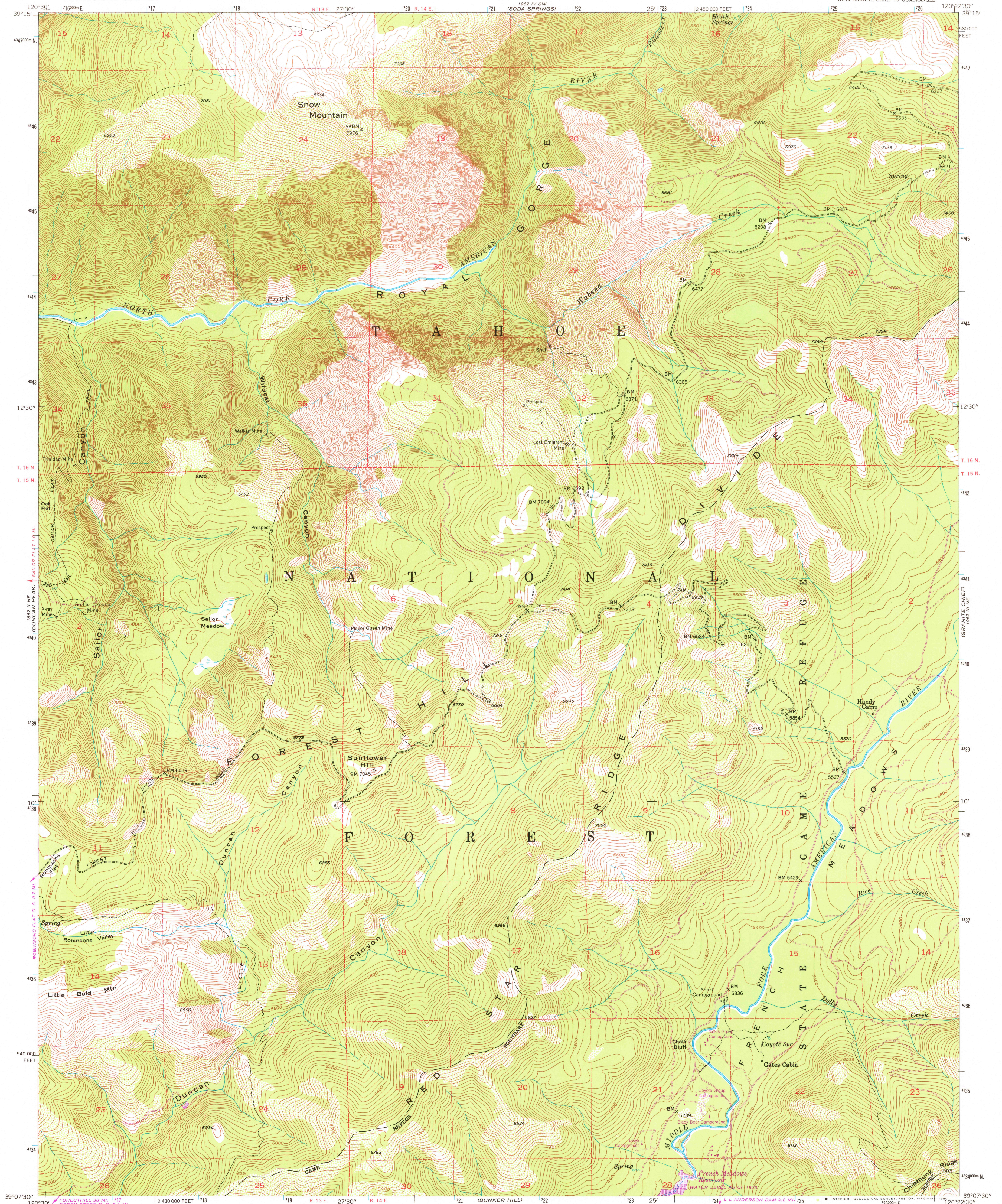

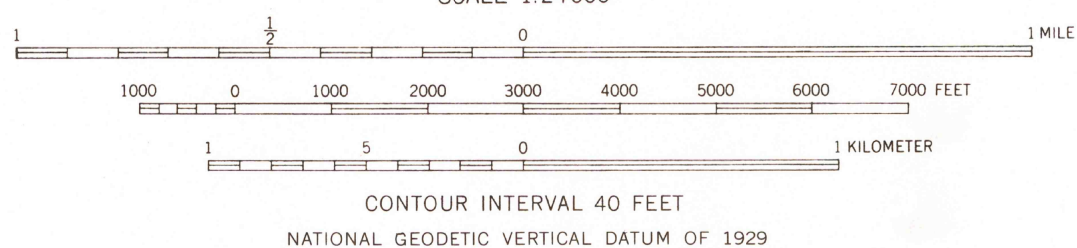
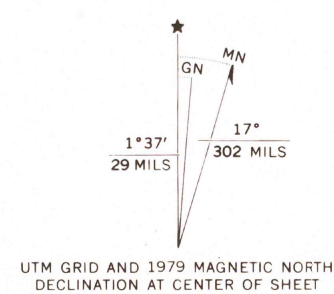

Polycyclic projection. 1927 North American datum. 10,000-foot grid based on California coordinate system, zone 1. 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 10, shown in blue.

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 1.4 meters north and 89 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks.

There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map.
