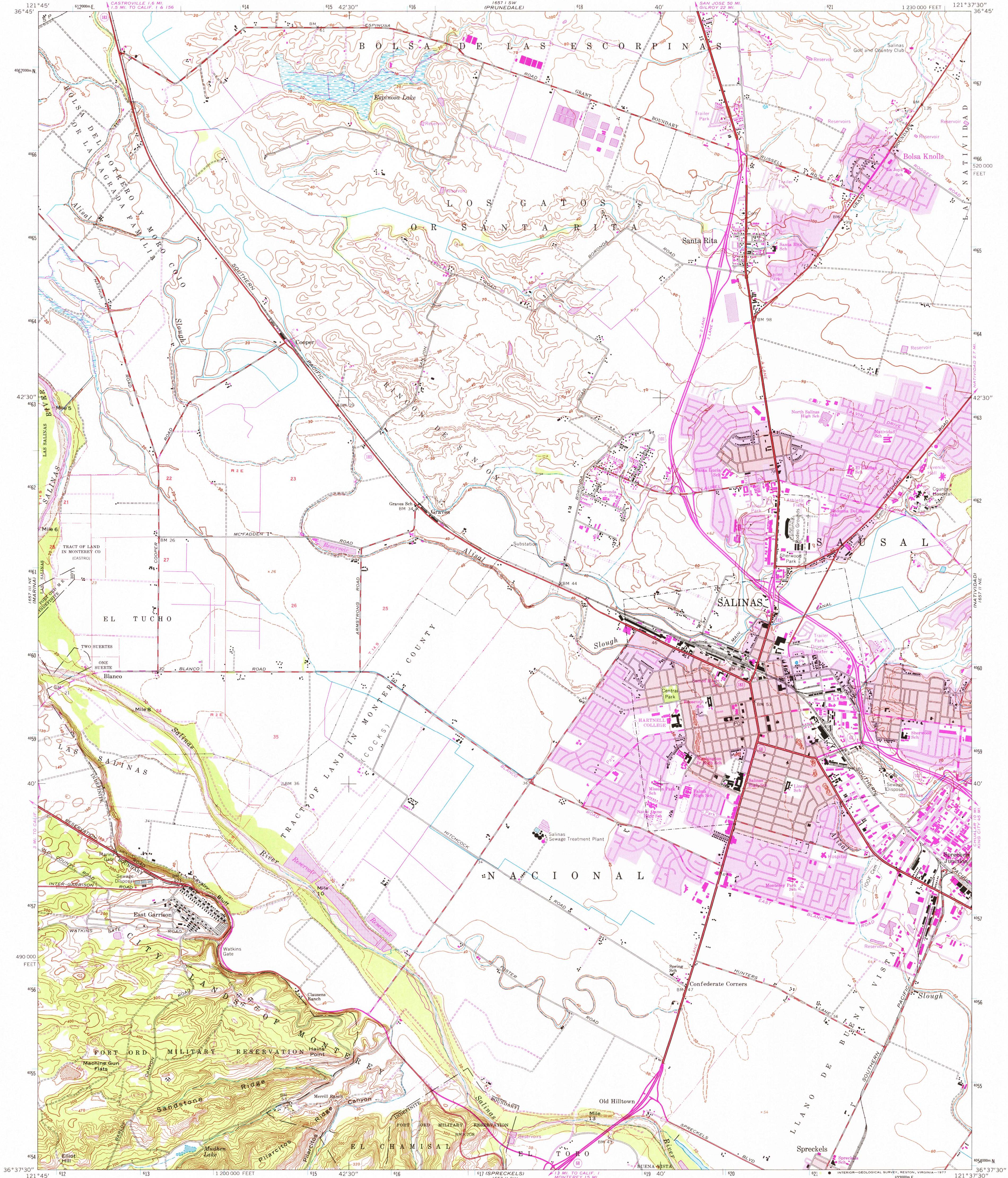

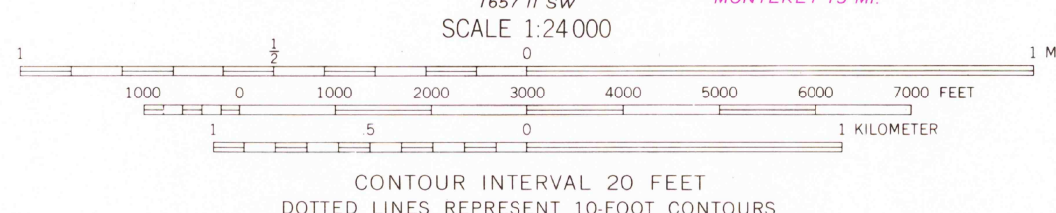
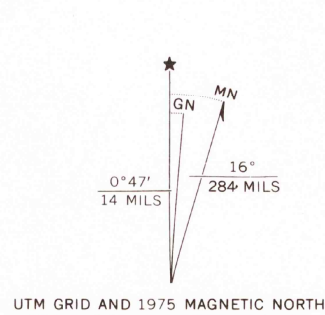
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,

No distinction is made between dwellings, barns, commercial, and industrial buildings

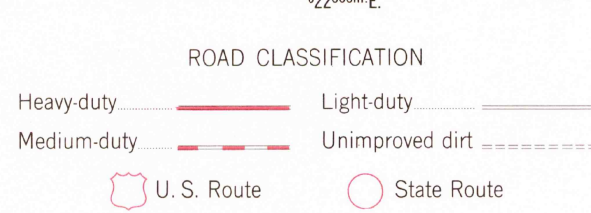
