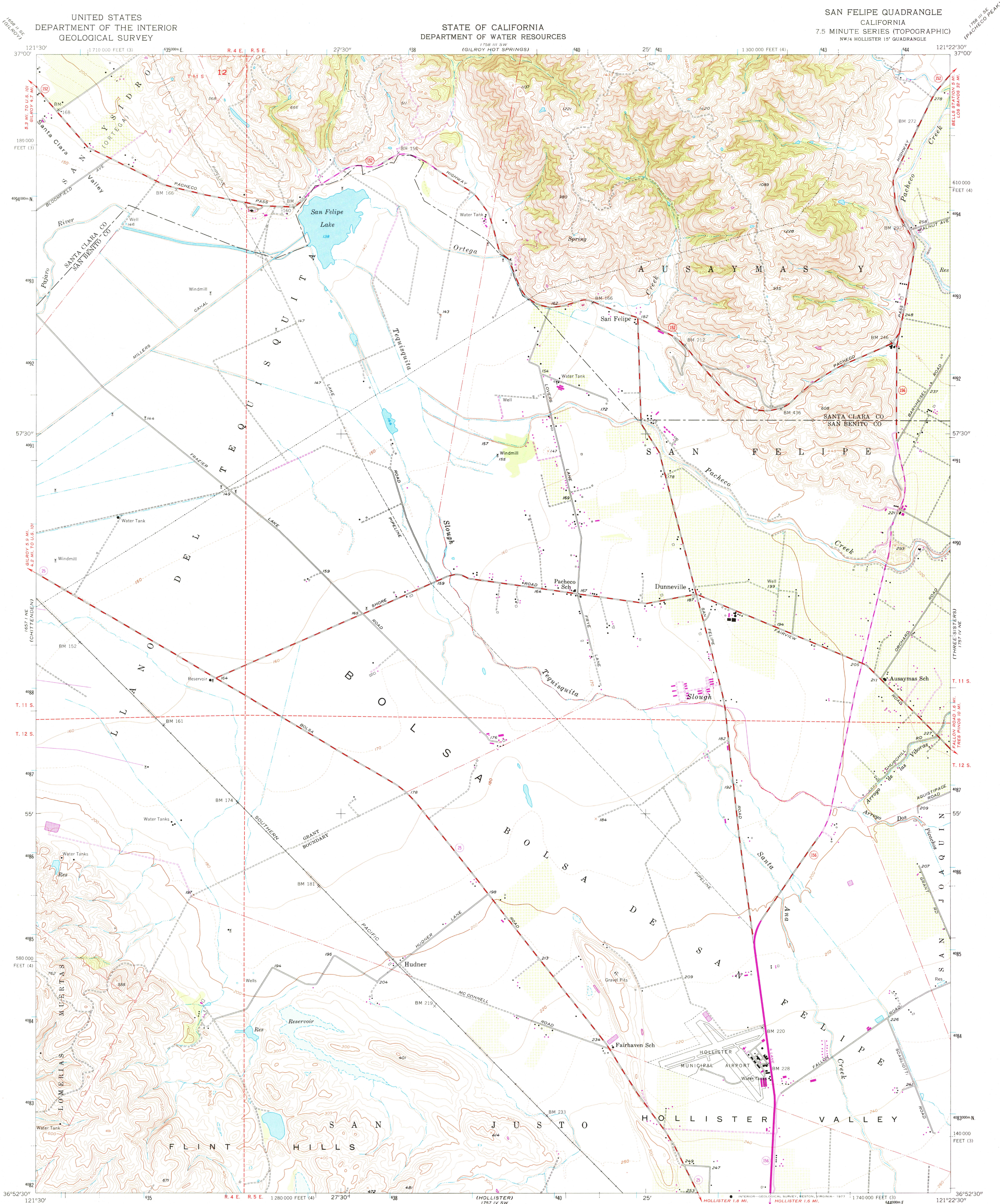

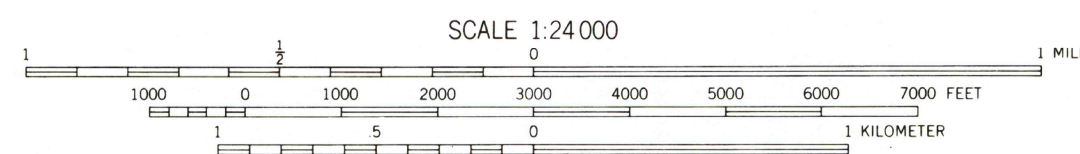
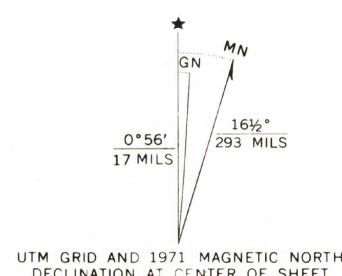
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grids based on California coordinate system, zones 3 and 4
