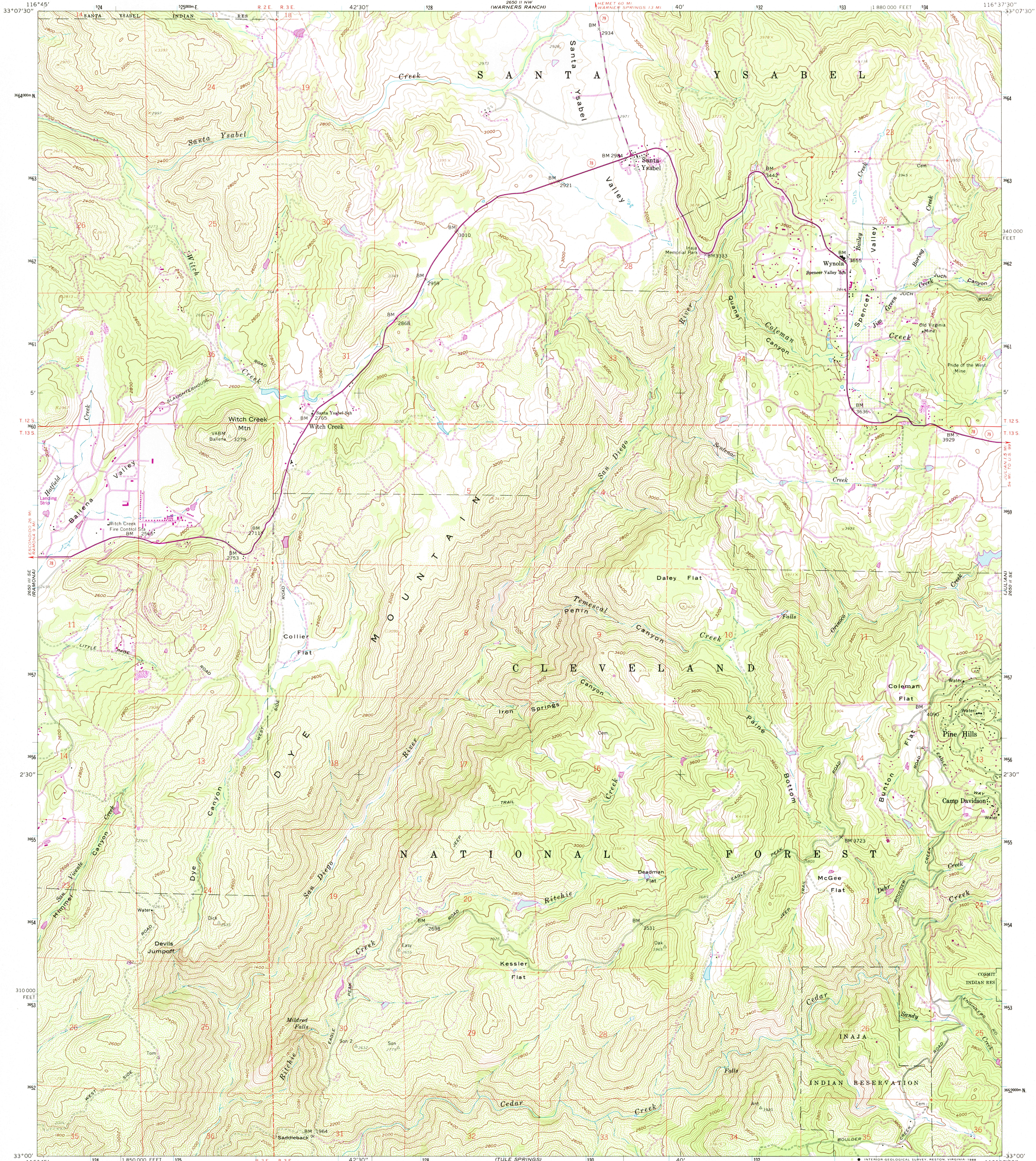

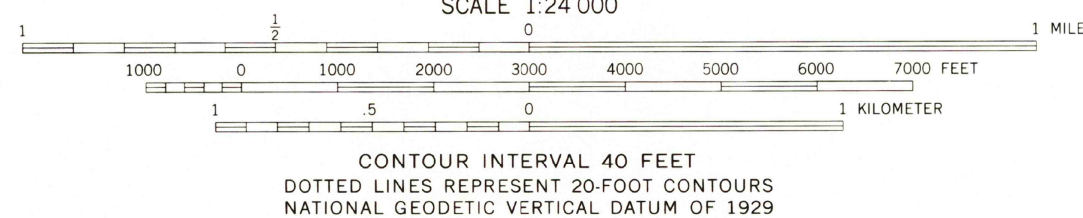
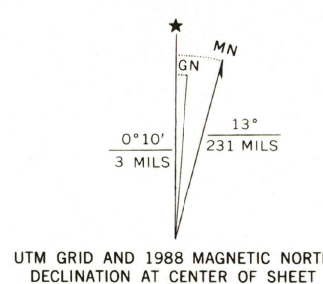
Topography from aerial photographs by photogrammetric methods

zone 11, shown in blue

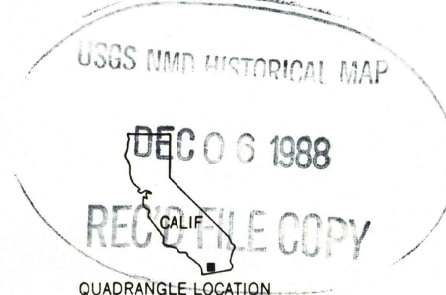
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983
