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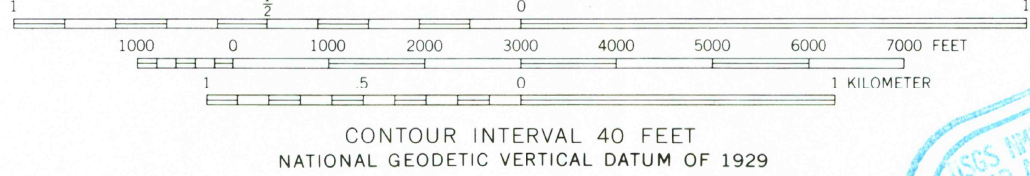
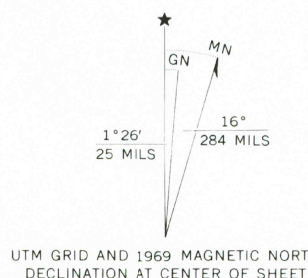
Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1967. Field checked 1969

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 8 meters north and 89 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

Fine red dashed line indicate selected fence lines
