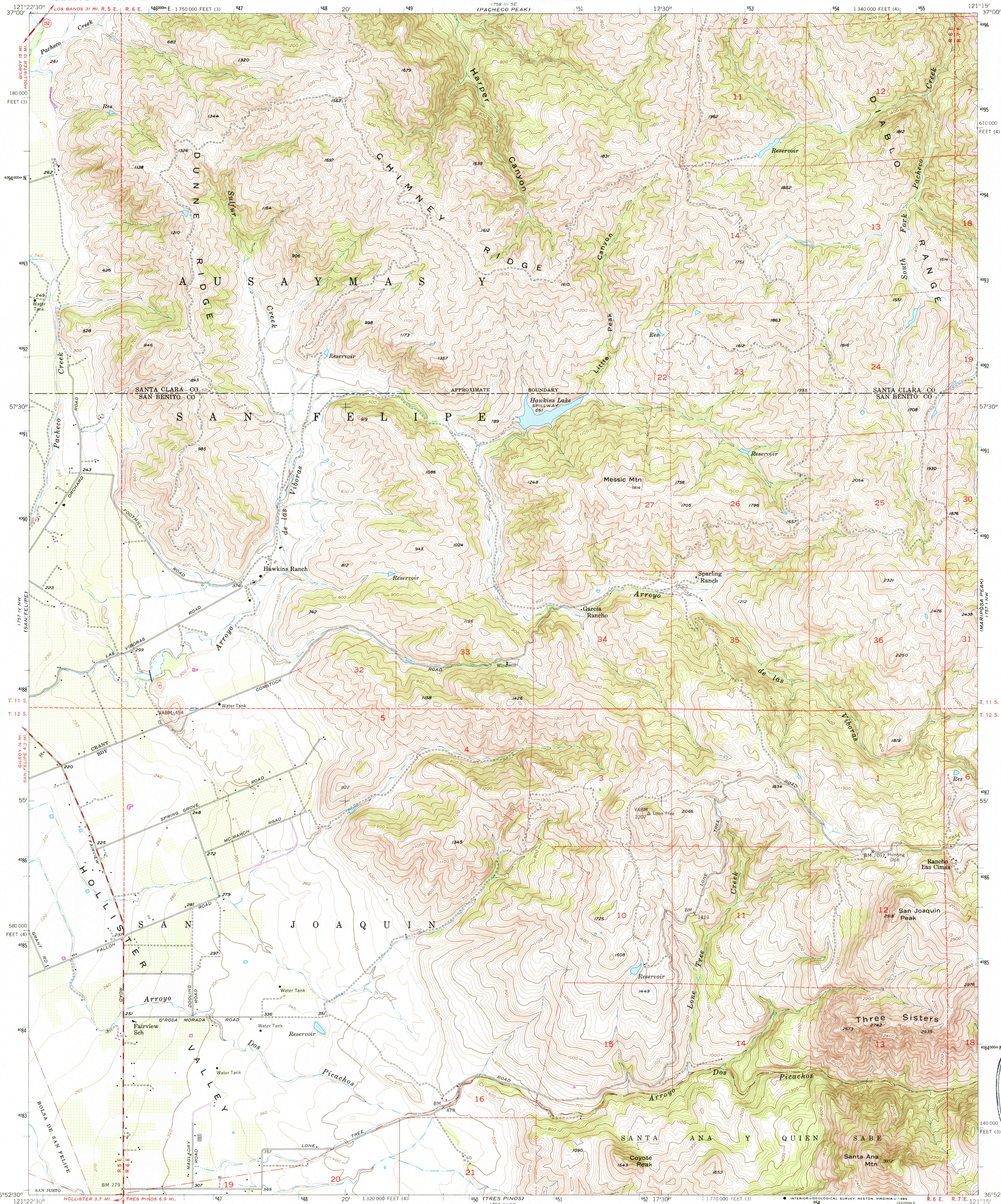

Polyconic projection, 1927 North American datum

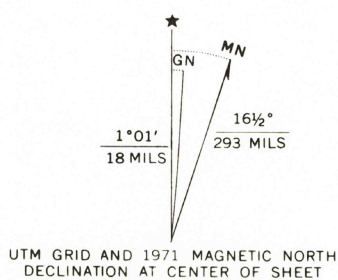
10,000-foot grids based on California coordinate system, zones 4 and 3
