Compiled by Army Map Service (AM), Corps of Engineers, War Department, using stereophotogrammetric methods (1947) from AAF aerial photography (1946). Control by USGS, USC&GS and AMS. Public land survey lines are based on the Mount Diablo Principal Meridian north of the Eighth Standard Parallel south, and on the San Bernardino Principal Meridian south of the Eighth Standard Parallel south. Land subdivision lines have not been verified in the field. Planimetry field edited, 1947.
