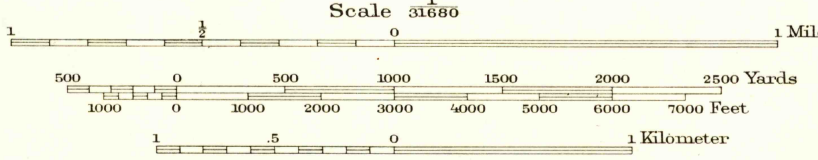

PENNINGTON QUADRANGLE



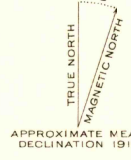
