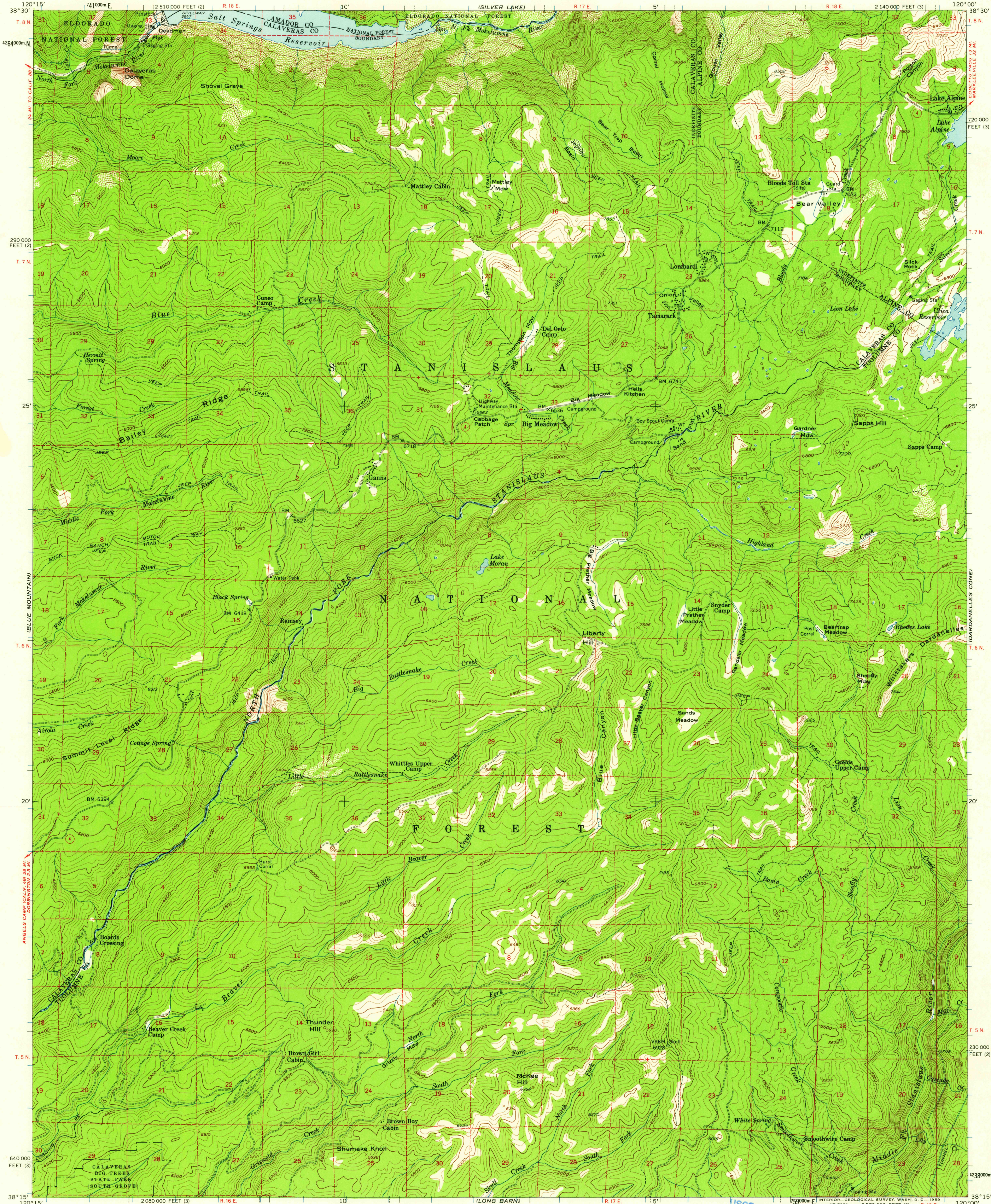

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 10, shown in blue

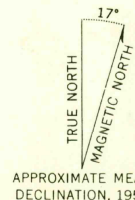
Land lines unsurveyed in parts of T. 6, 7 and 8 N., R. 17 and 18 E.

Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations

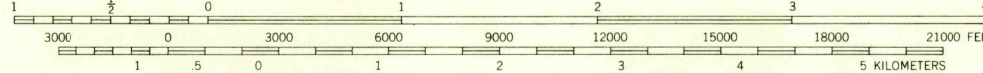
