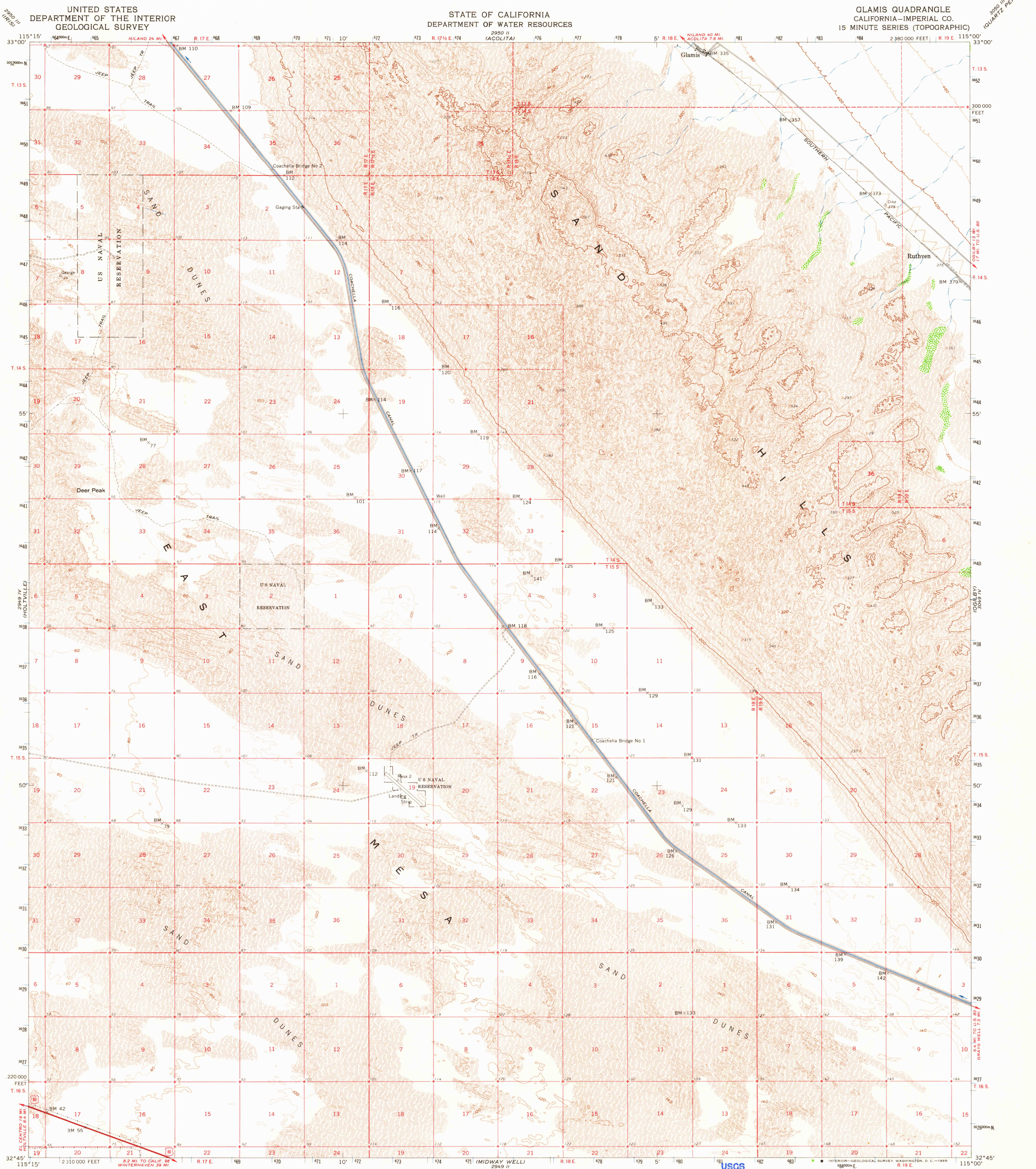




Maped, edited, and published by the Geological Survey
