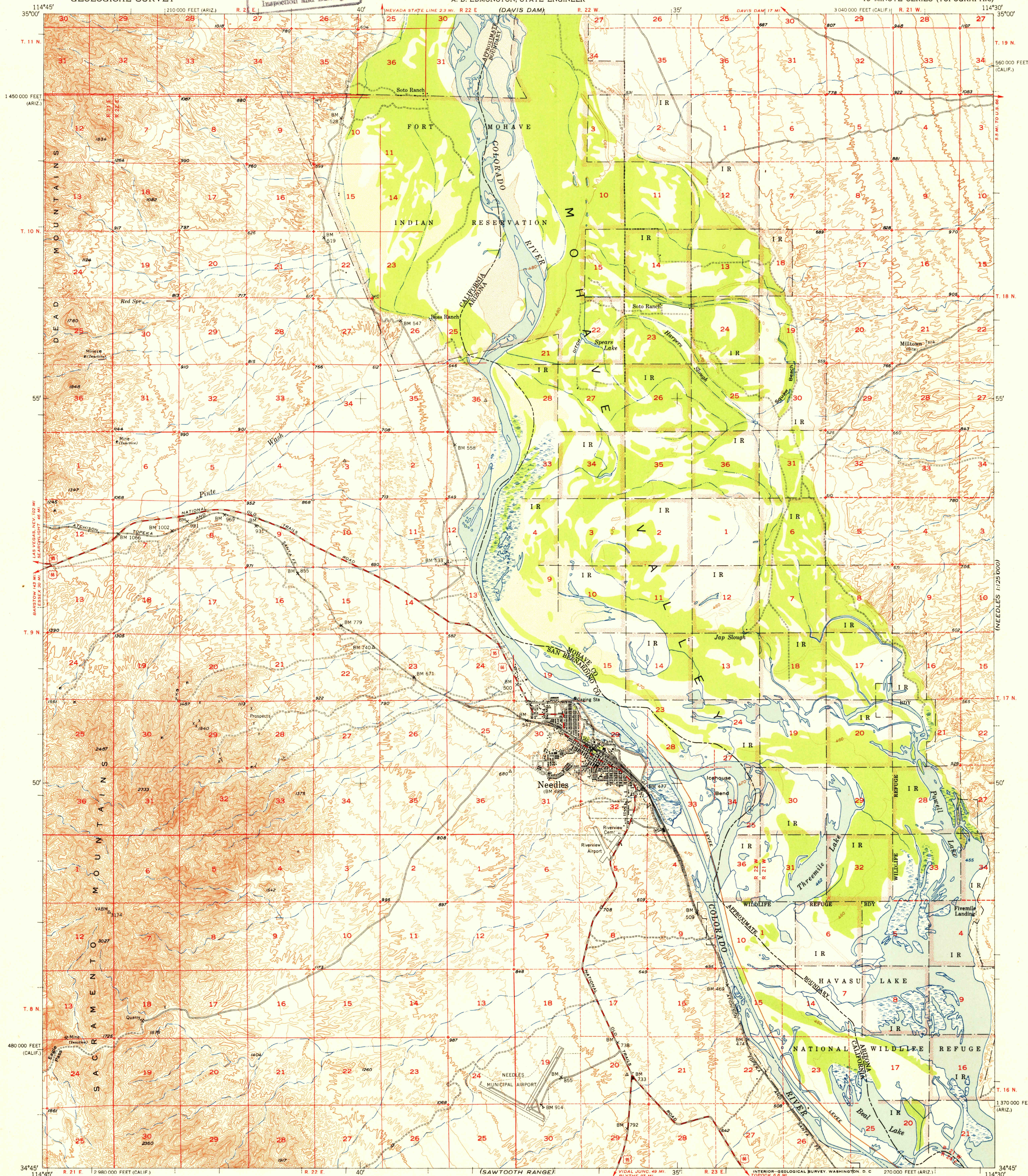




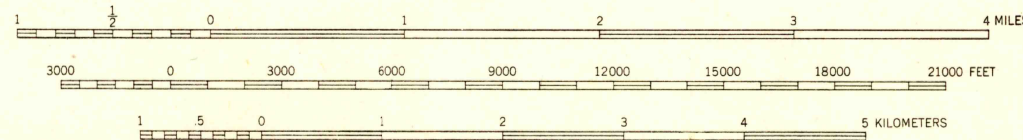
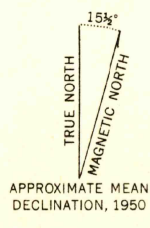

California-Arizona boundary shown from best available information.

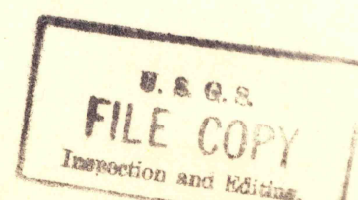
