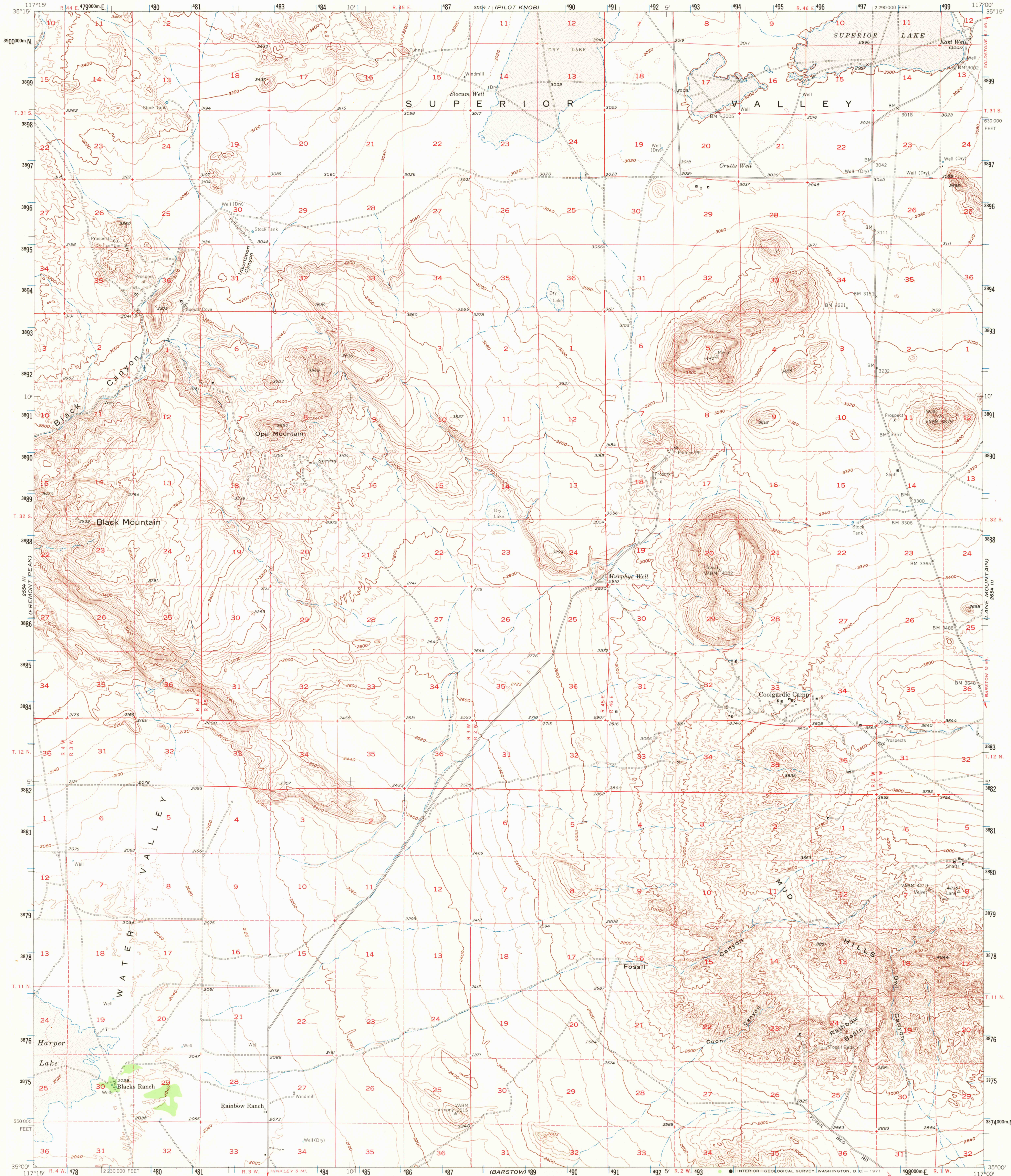

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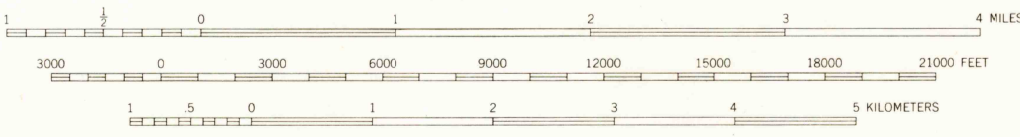
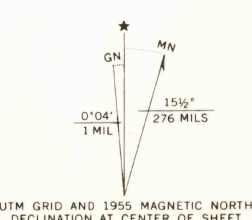
Topography from aerial photographs by photogrammetric methods and by planetarium surveys 1955. Aerial photographs taken 1950
