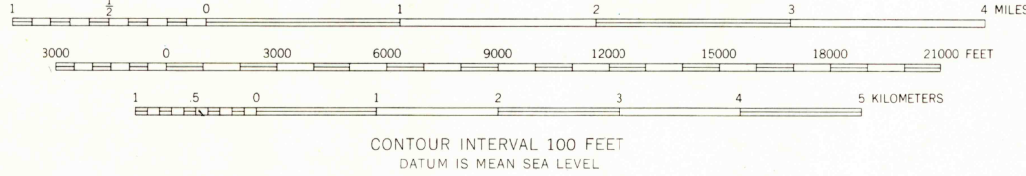
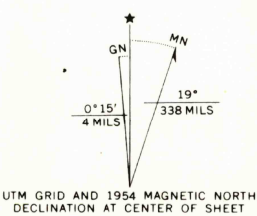




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Aerial photographs taken 1944 and 1947. Field check by USGS 1954
