

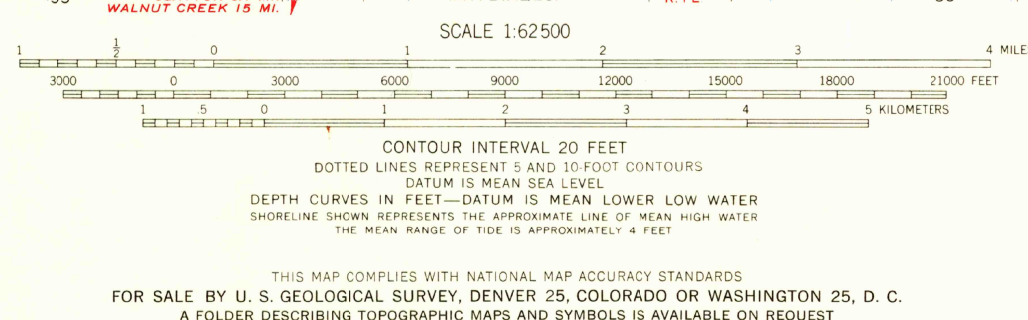

surveyed in 1953
Culture and drainage by USC&GS from aerial photographs taken 1941
Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1949
and by planetable surveys
Hydrography compiled from USC&GS charts 5527 and 5534 (1952)
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum
10,000-foot grids based on California coordinate system, zones 2 & 3
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,
zone 10, shown in blue
Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown
