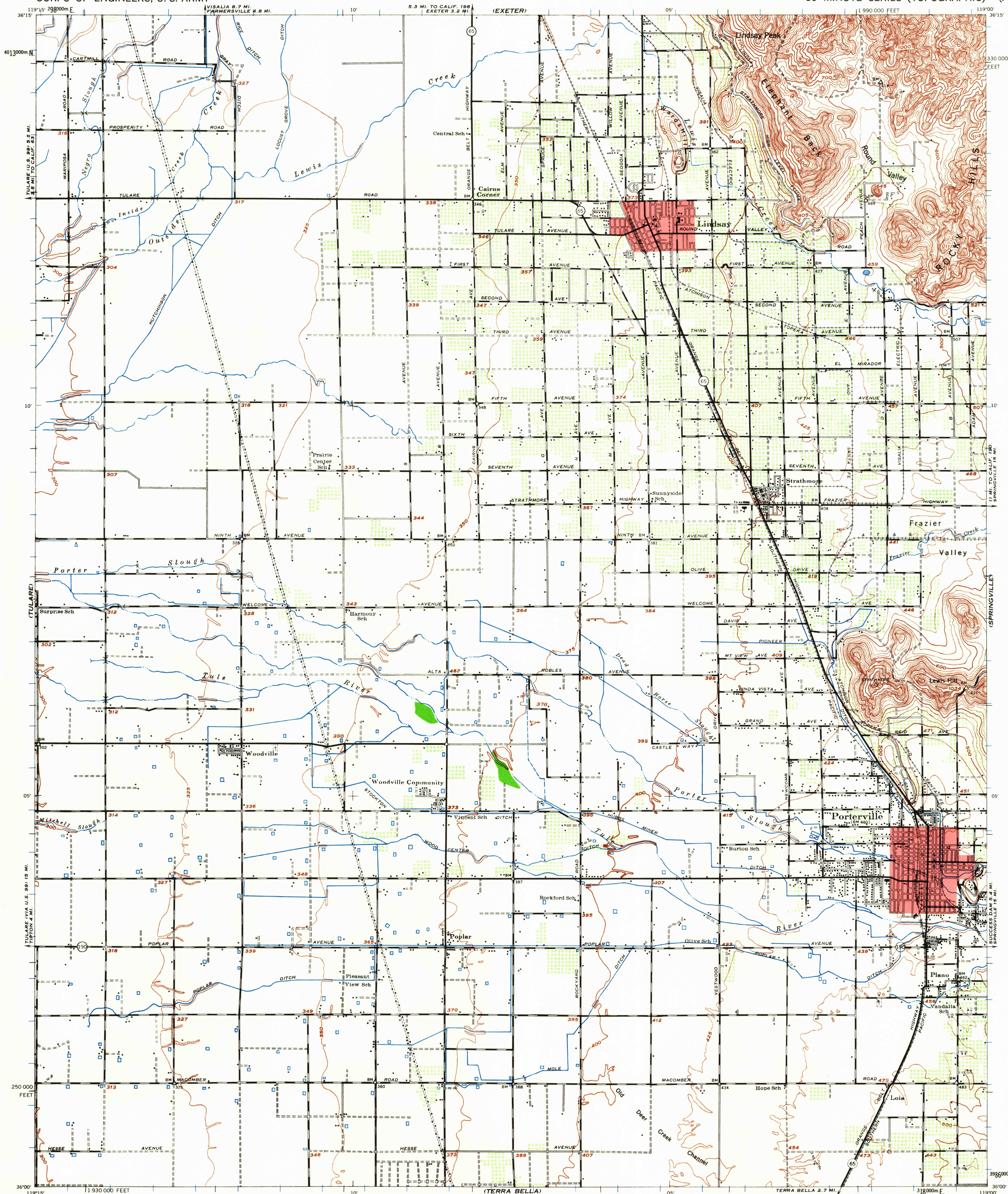

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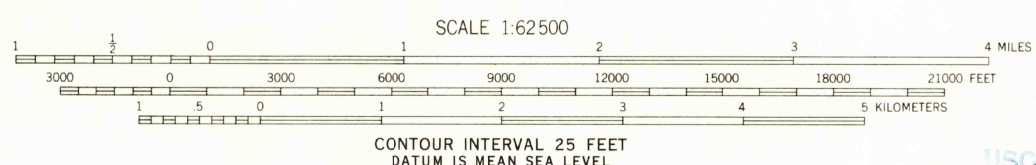
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1925-1926. Planimetric detail revised by Corps of Engineers, 1942.
