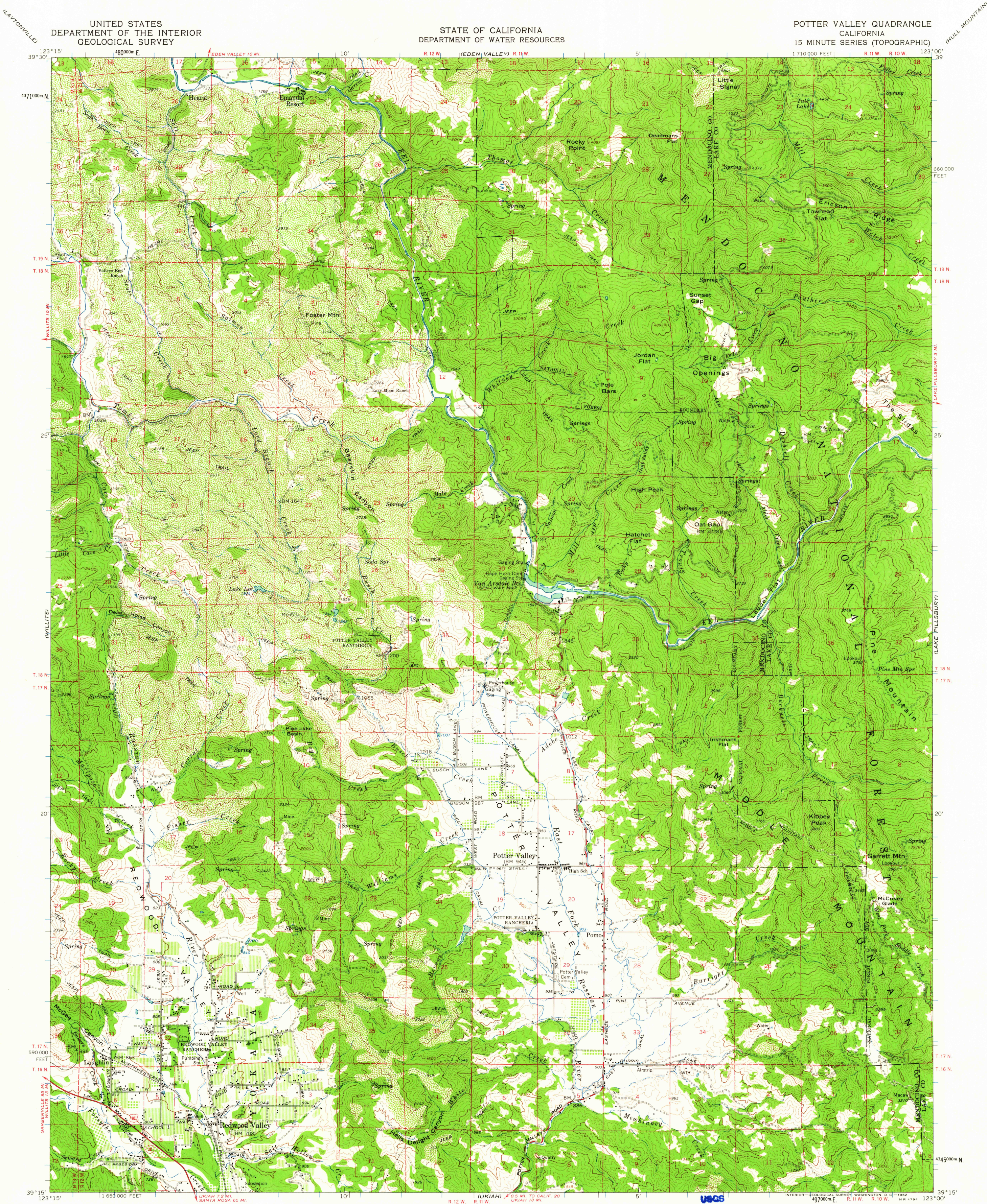

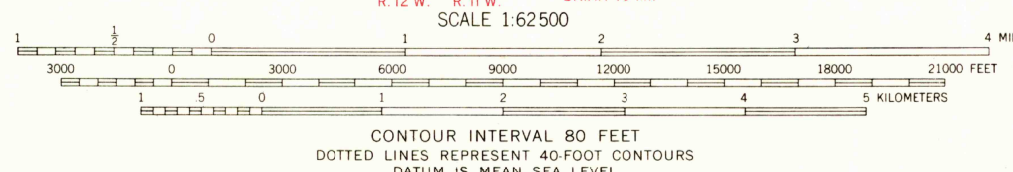
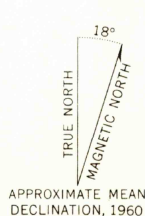
South half compiled in 1962 from 1:24 000-scale maps dated 1960
