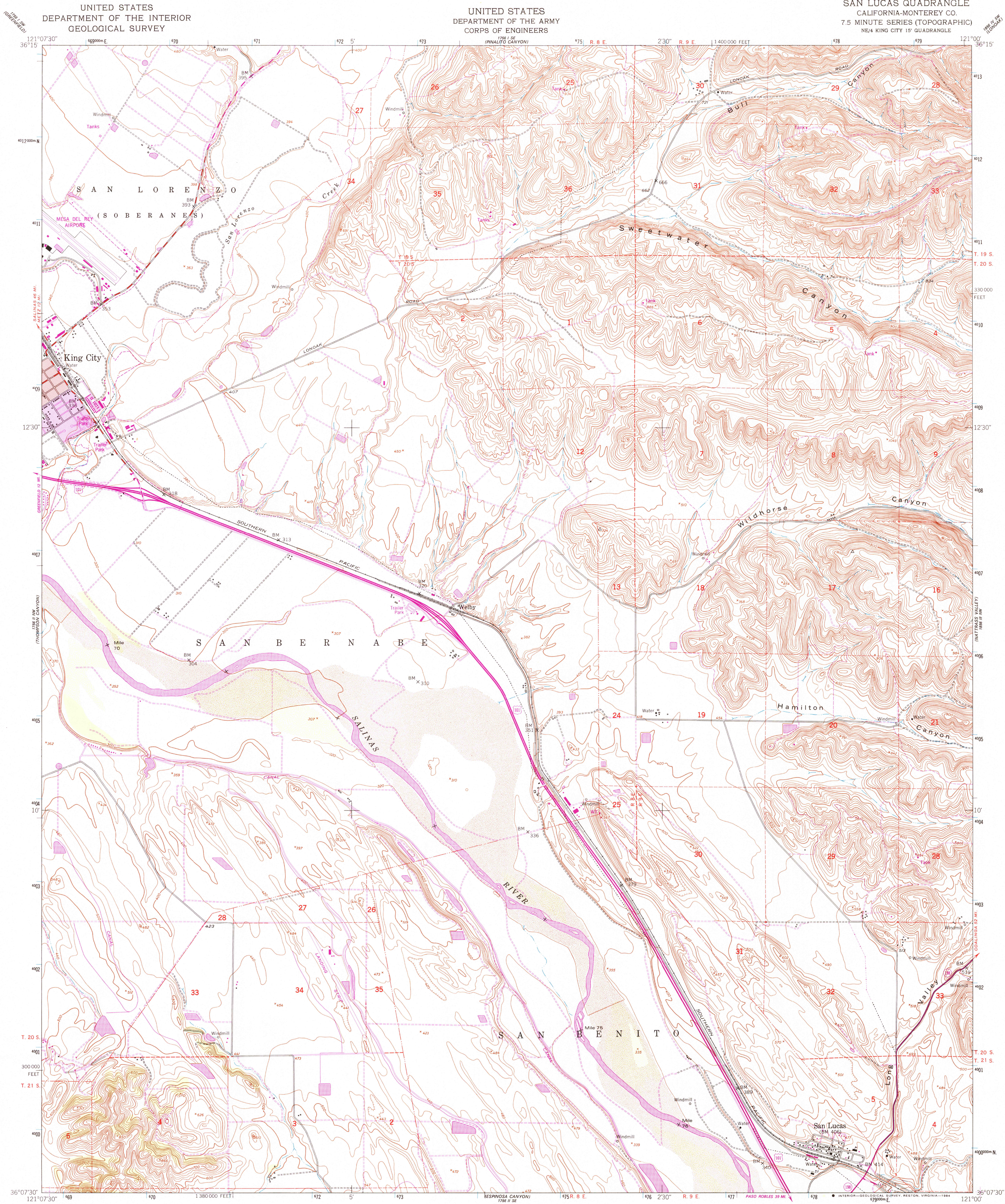

Unchecked elevations are shown in brown
Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations
