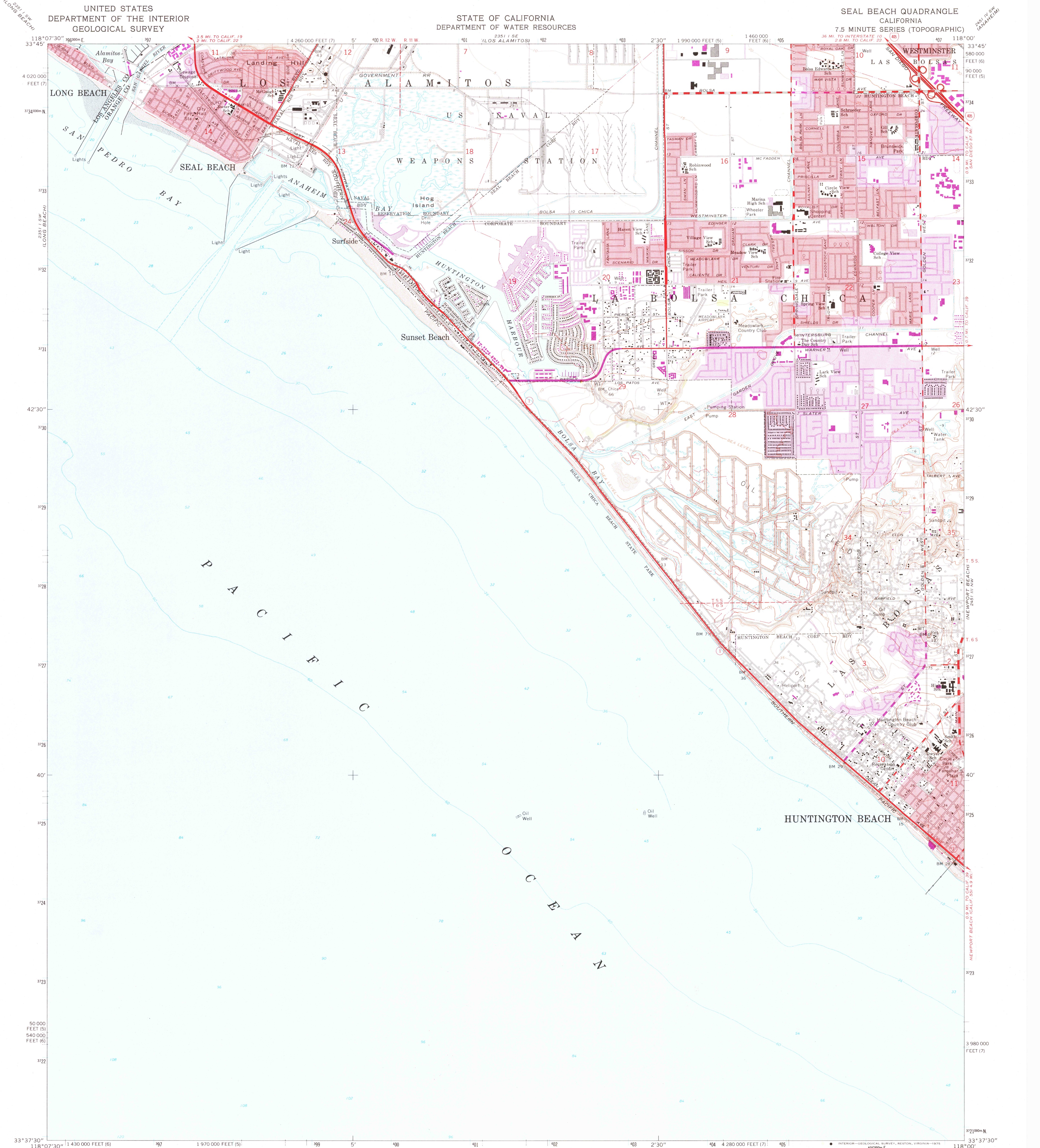

10,000-foot grids based on California coordinate system, zones 6, 7, and 5

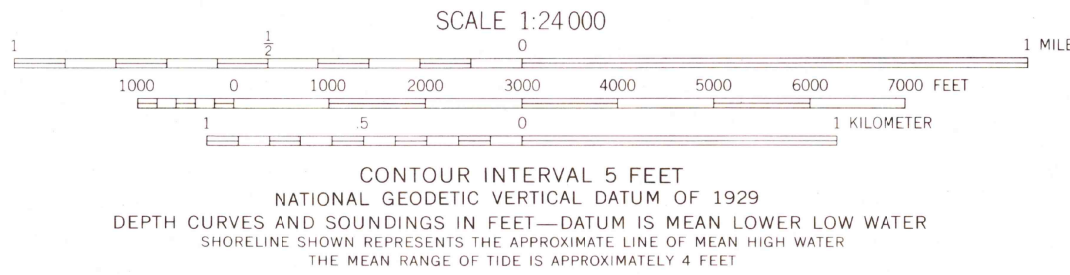
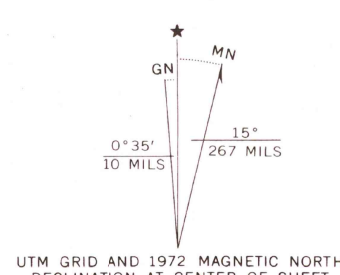
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 11, shown in blue

Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown

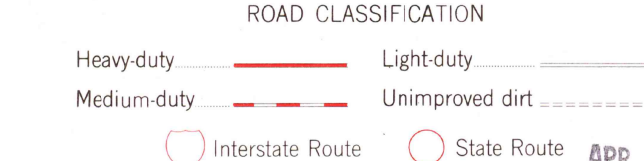
Dotted land lines established by private survey
