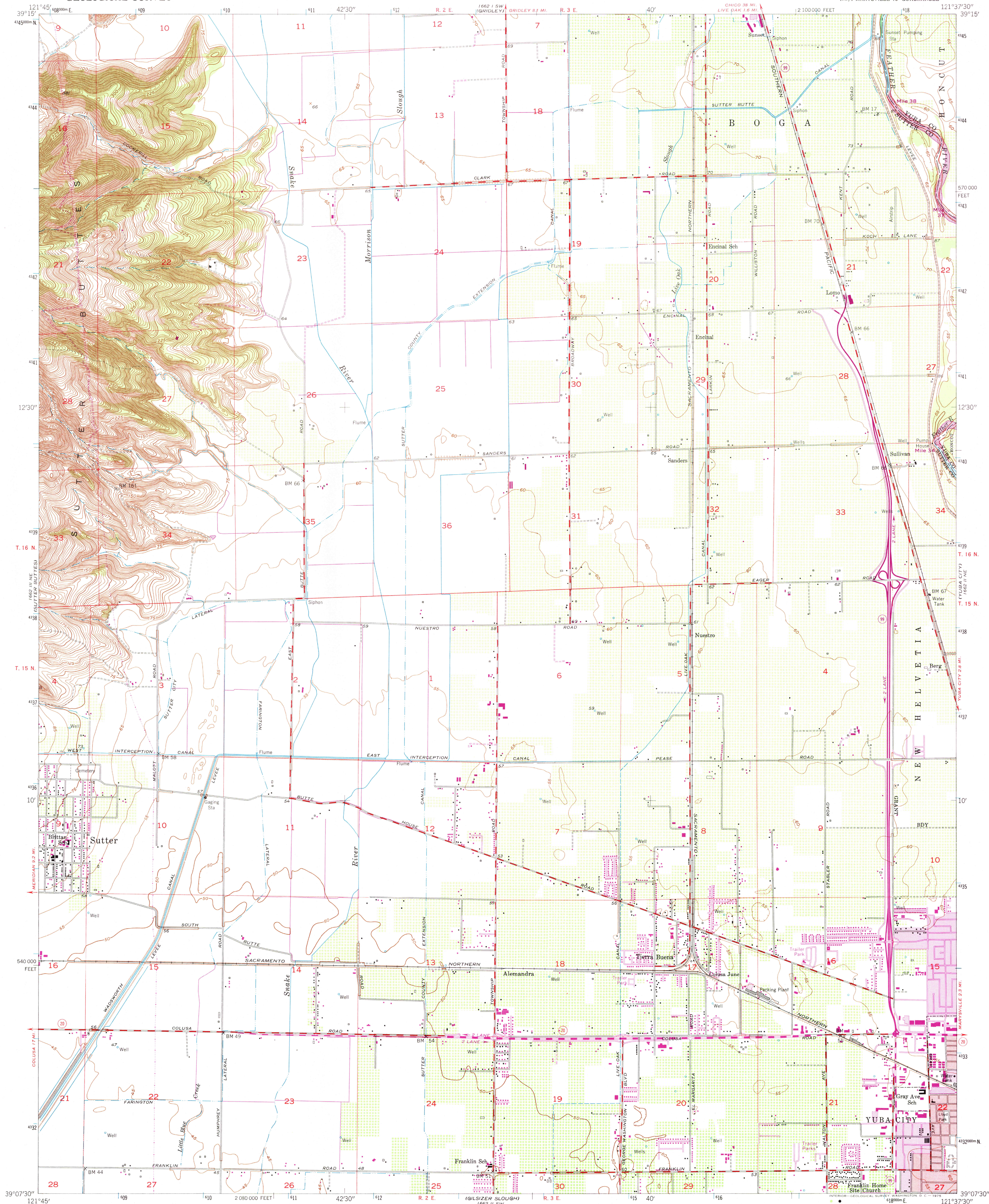

Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown

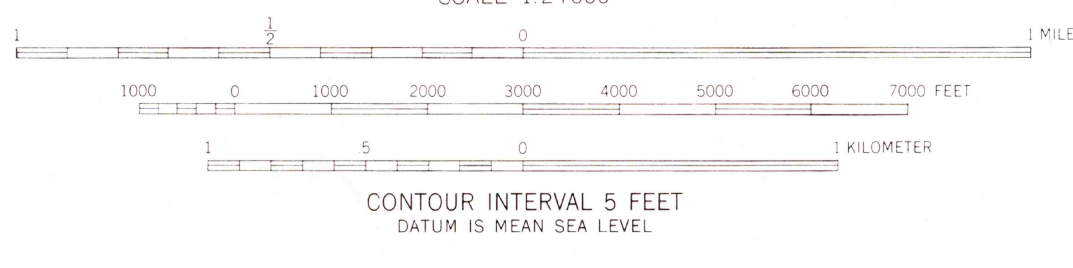
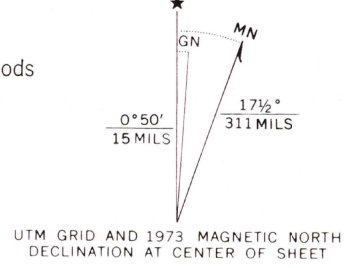
Land grant boundaries which follow the banks of
