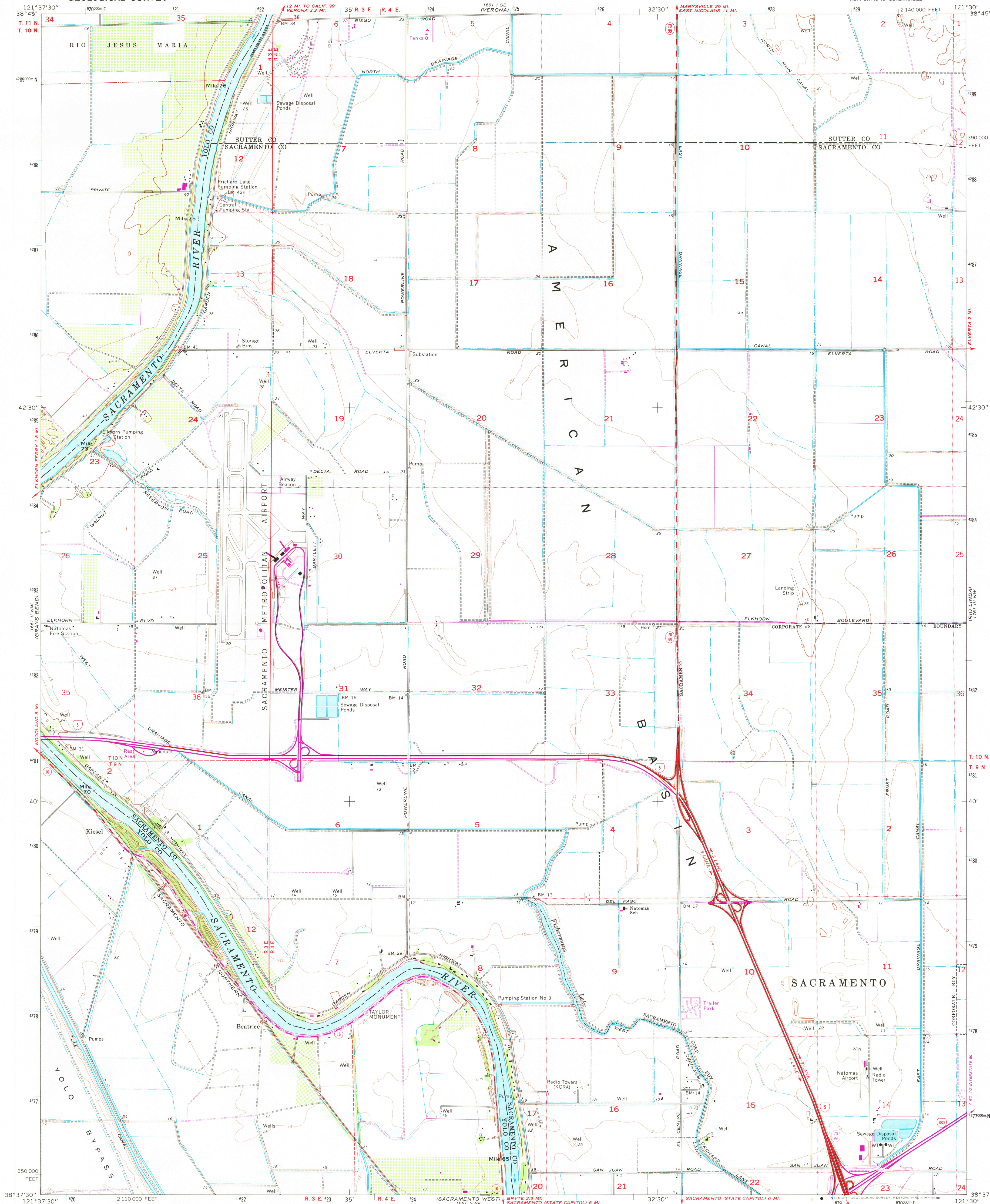
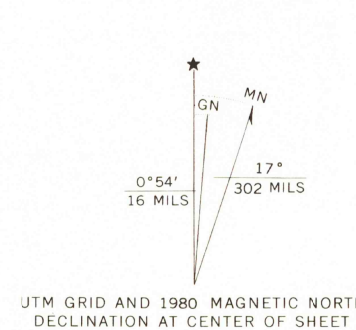

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,  
zone 10, shown in blue  
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983  
move the projection lines 15 meters north and  
92 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks  
Yolo Bypass area subject to inundation during periods of high water  
Dotted land lines established by private survey  
Where omitted, land lines have not been established
