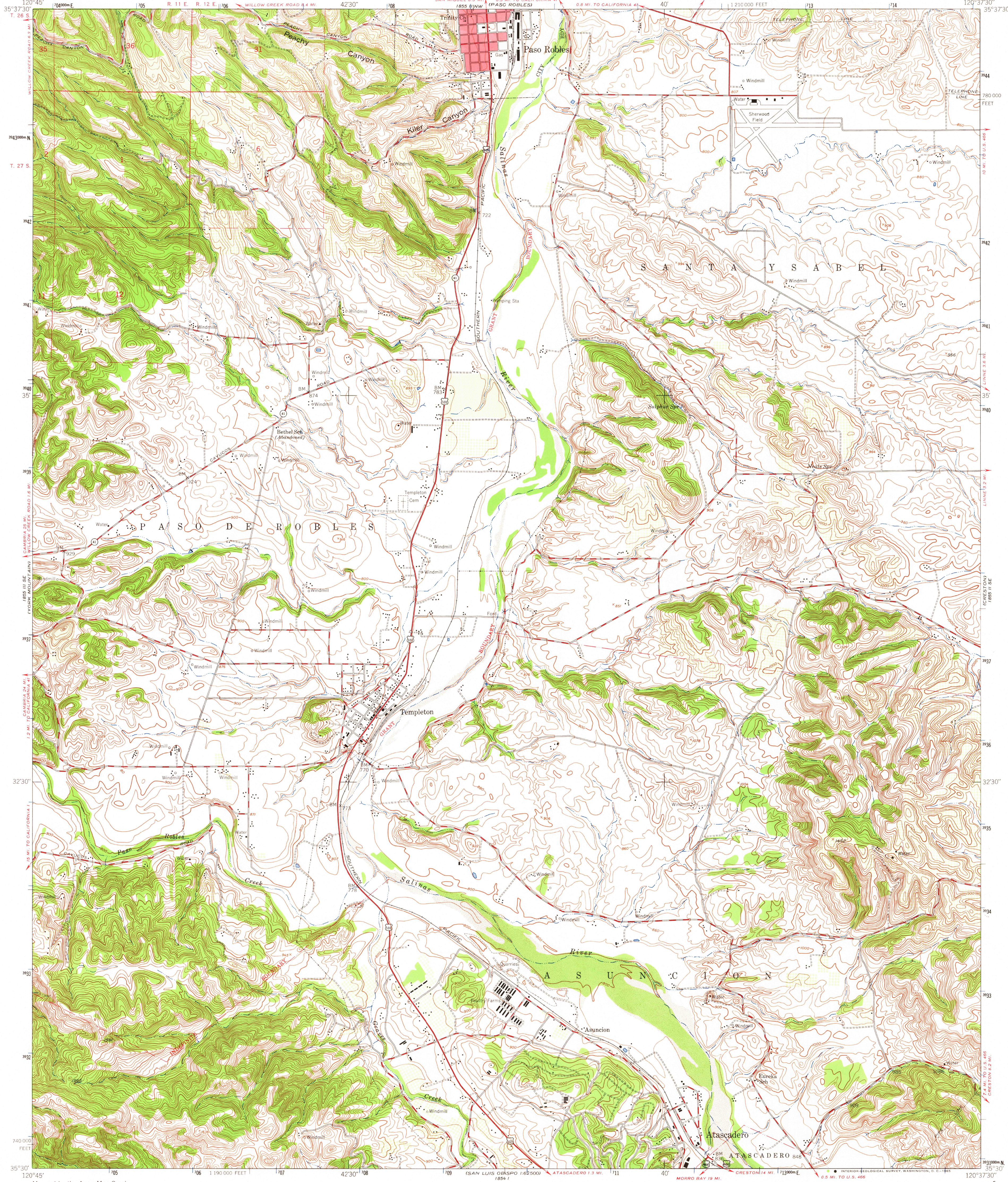

zone 5

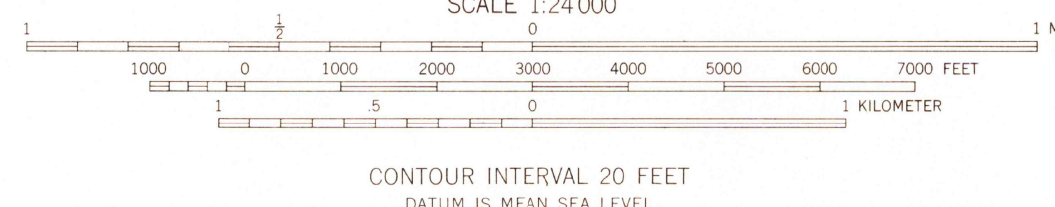
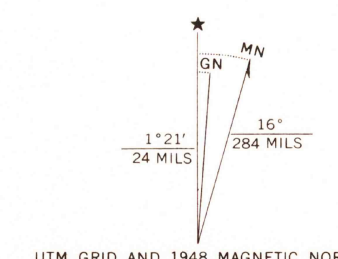
Red tint indicates area in which only
