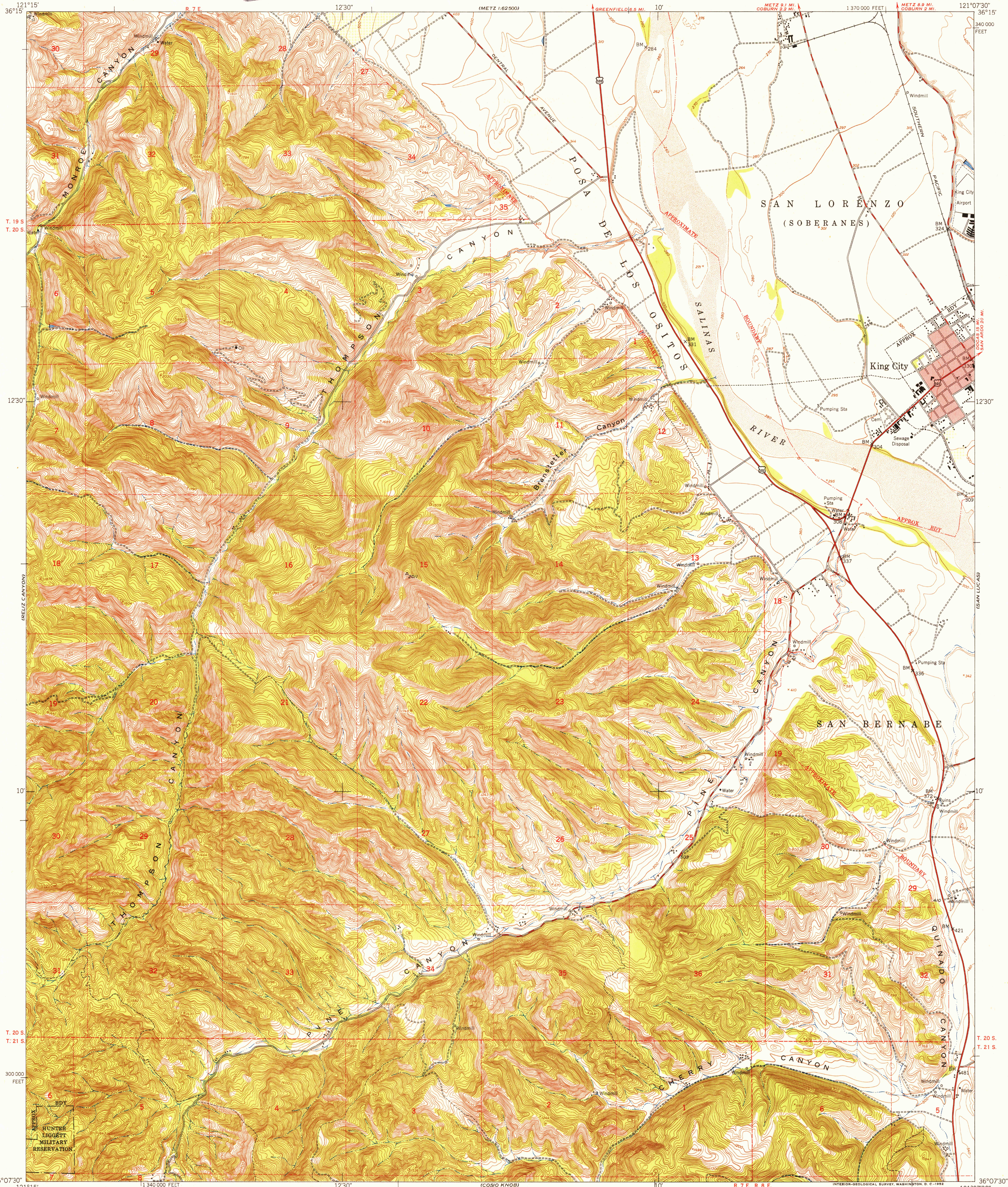




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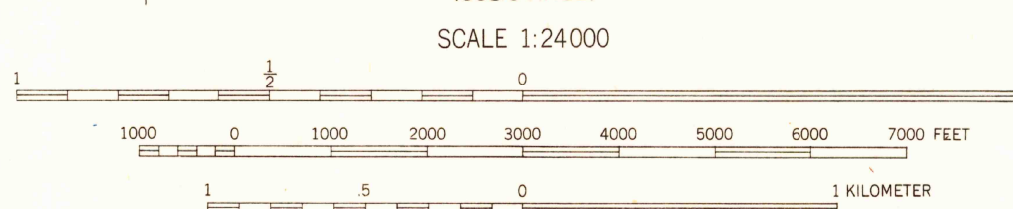
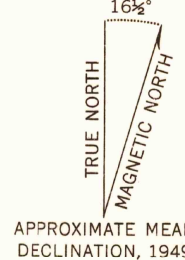

zone 4

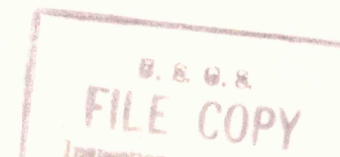
Red tint indicates area in which only
