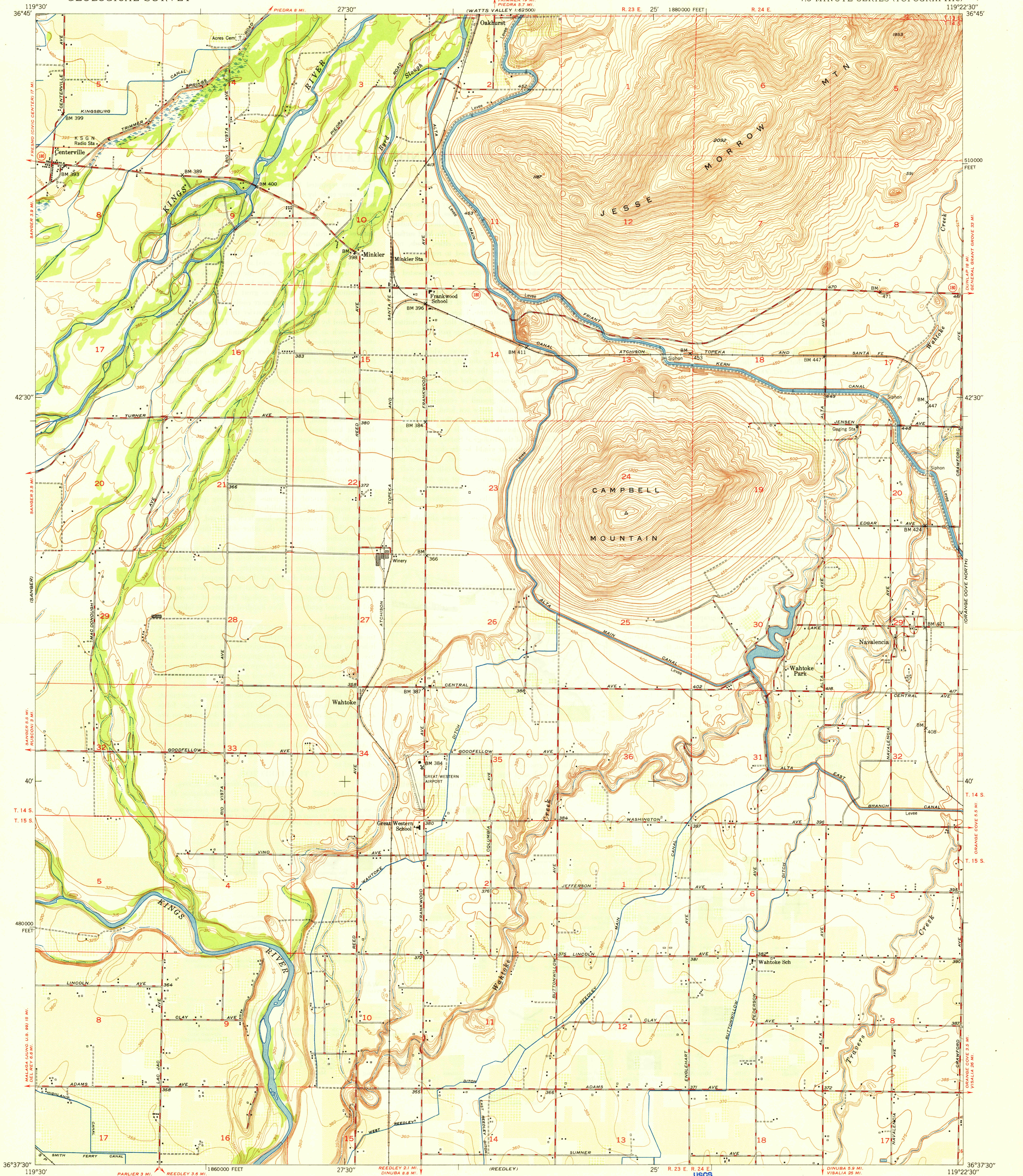




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Planimetry and 5 foot contours by plane-table 1921,
