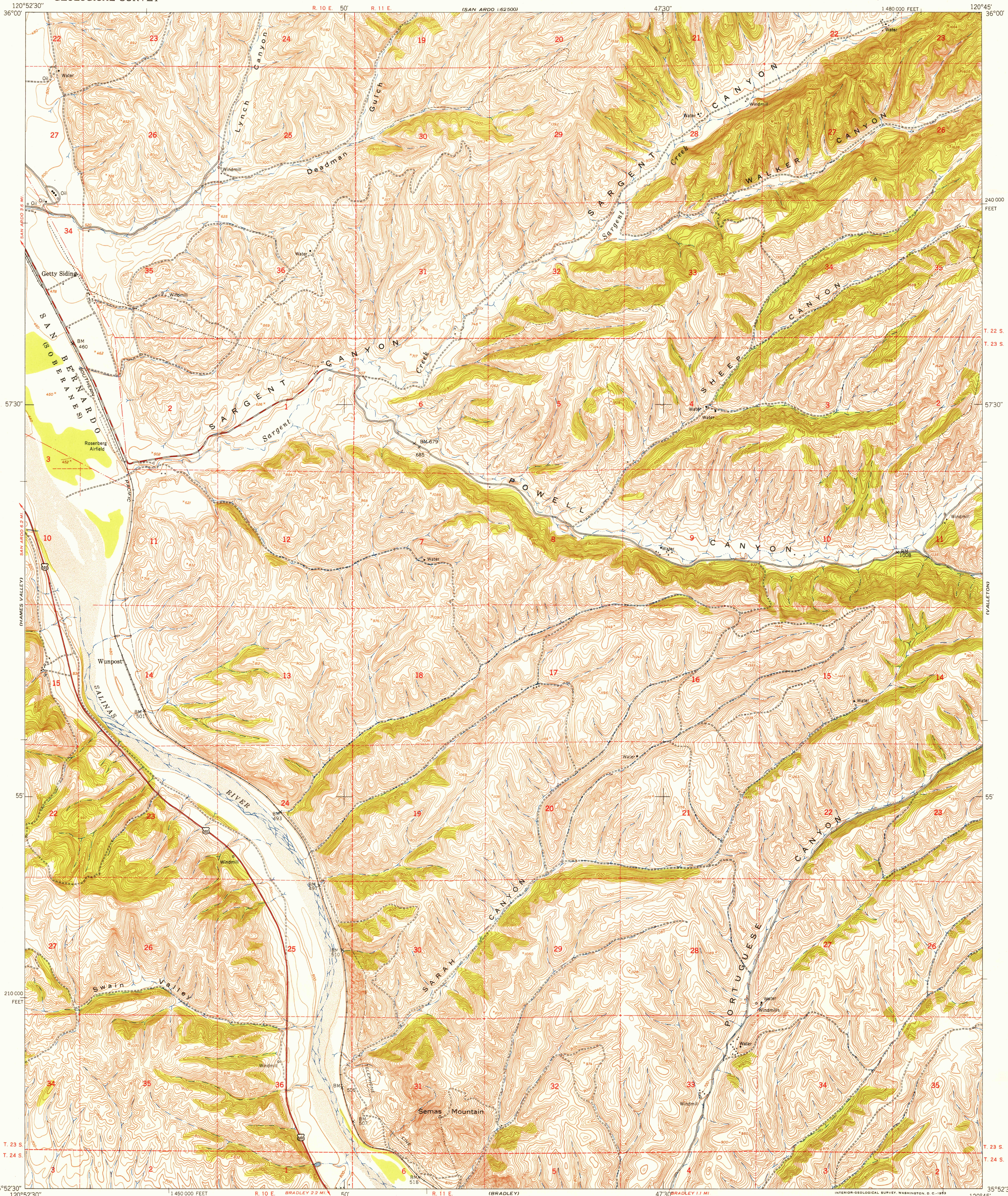
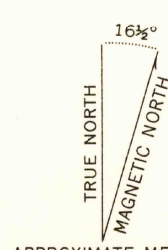
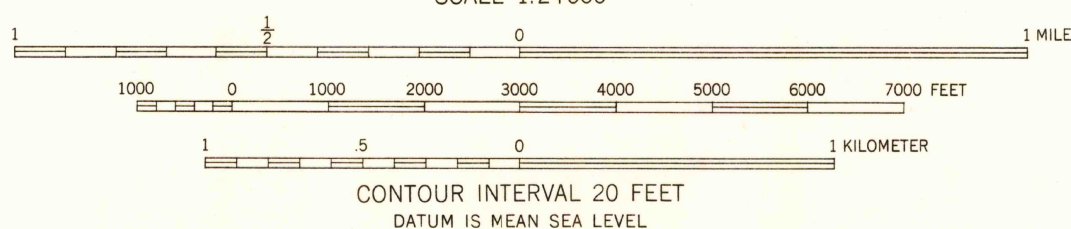

DECLINATION, 1949



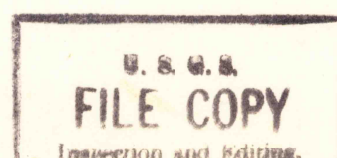
