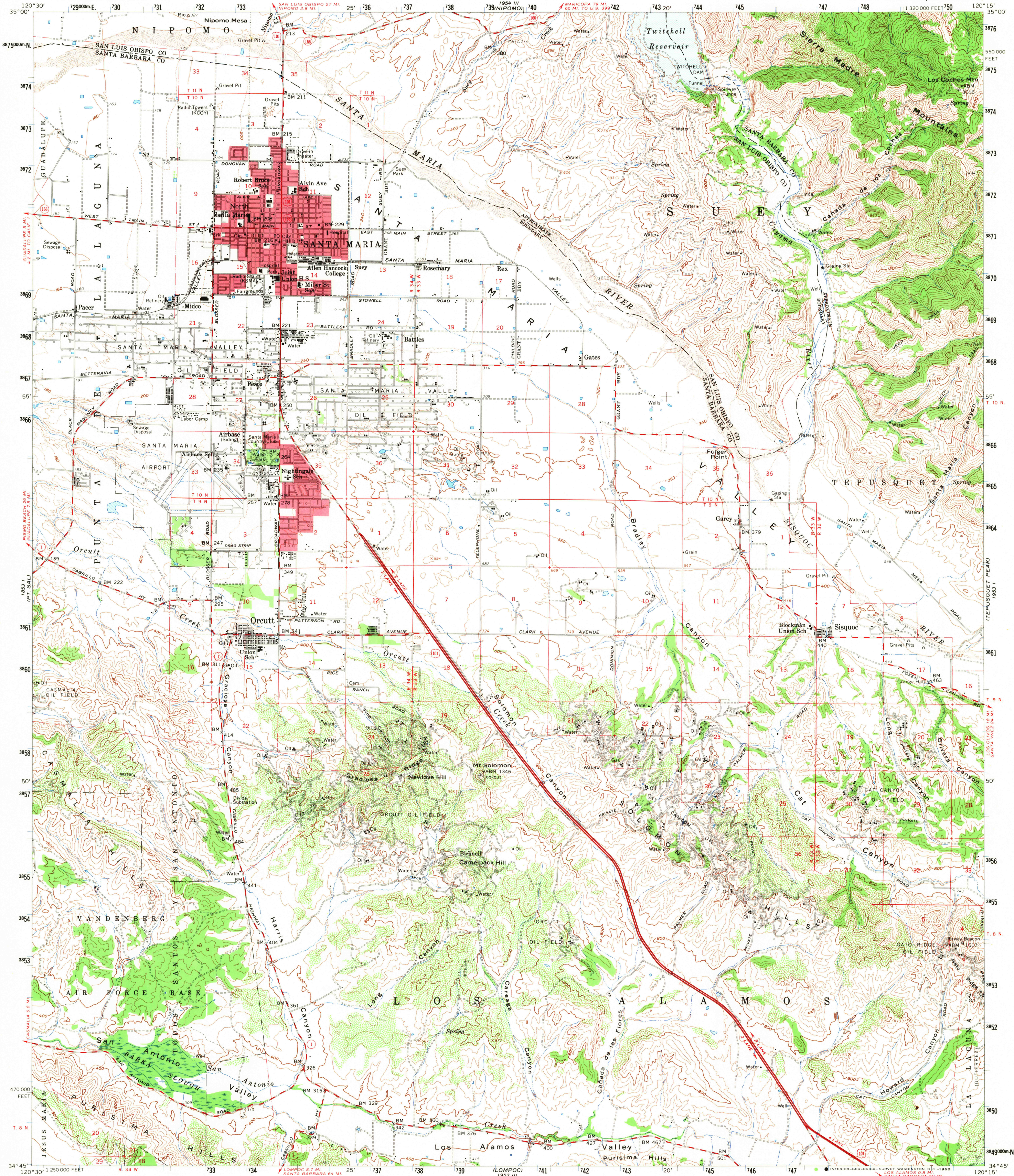

10,000-foot grid based on California coordinate system, zone 5

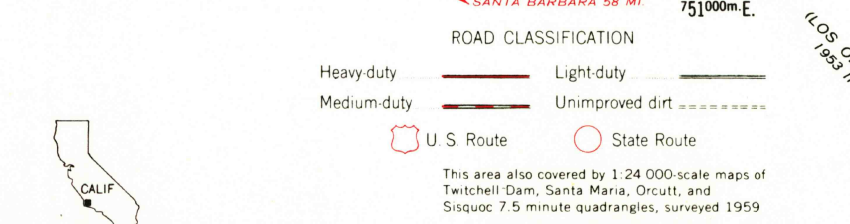
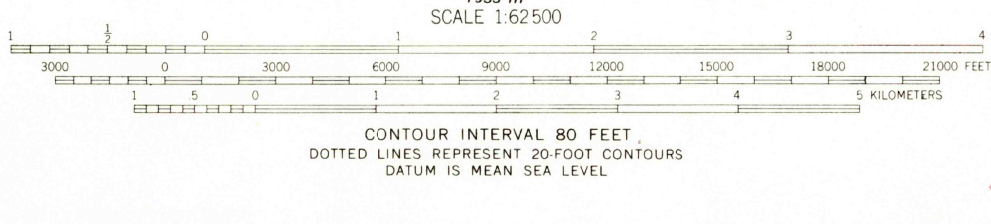
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,
