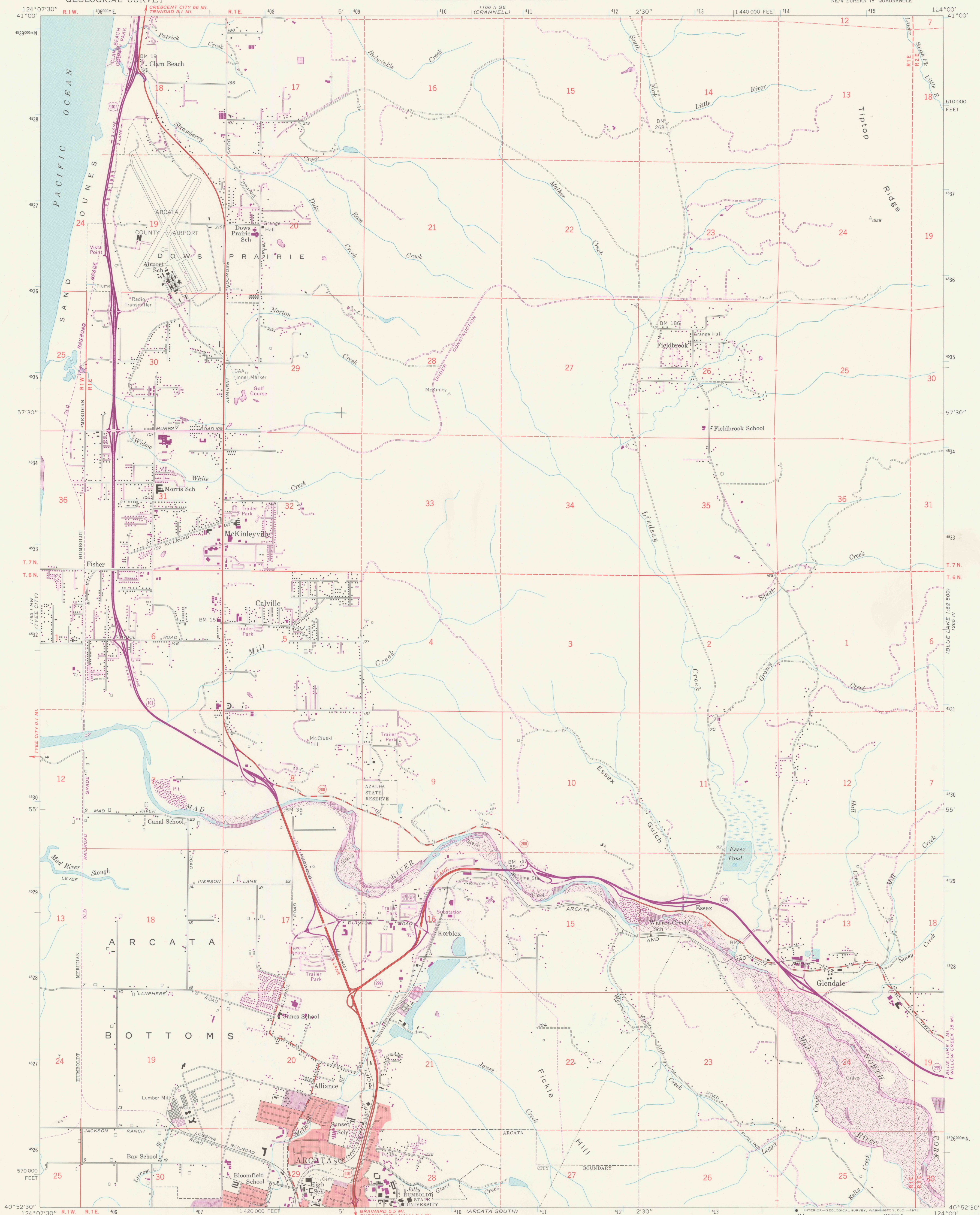

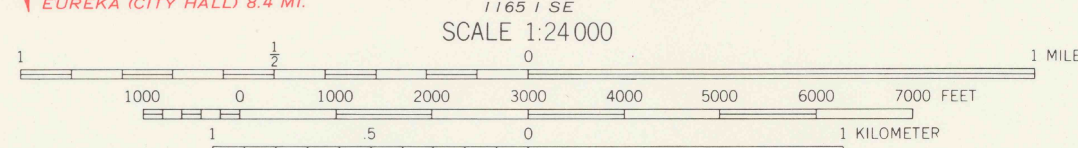
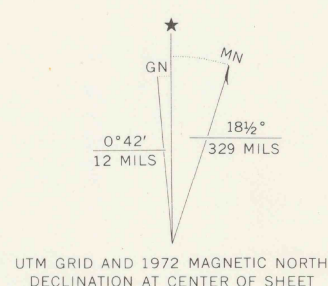
Topography from aerial photographs by photogrammetric methods and by planetable surveys 1959. Aerial photographs taken 1956
