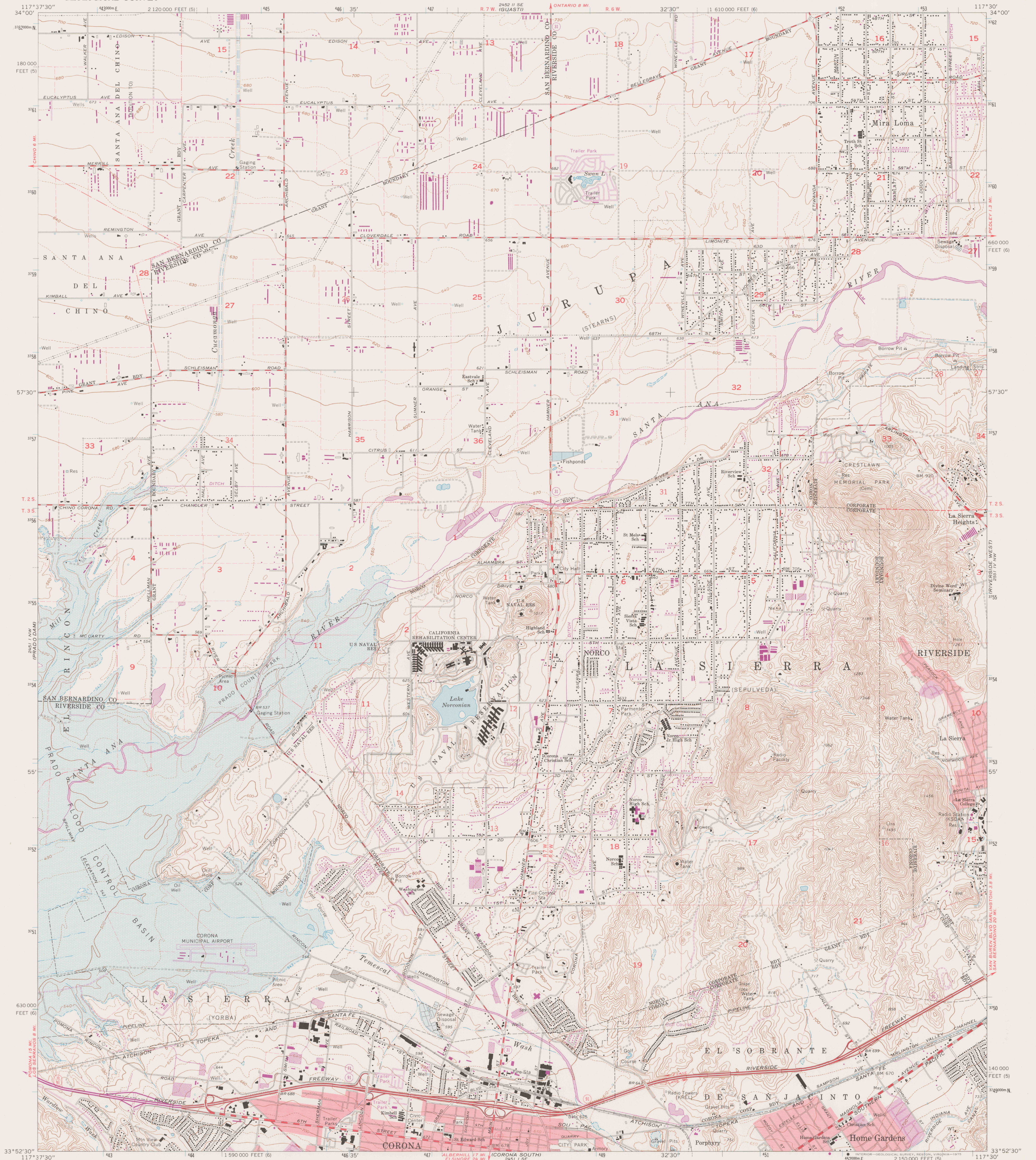

Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown

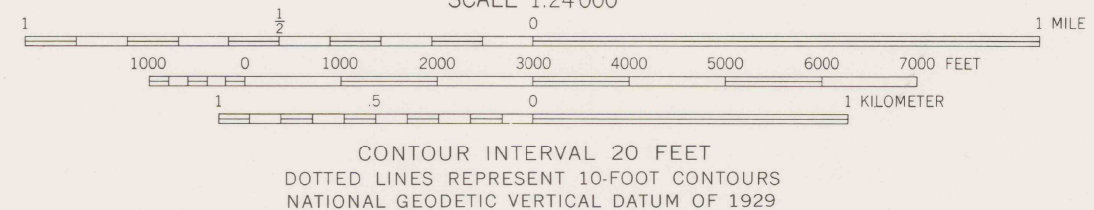
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines
