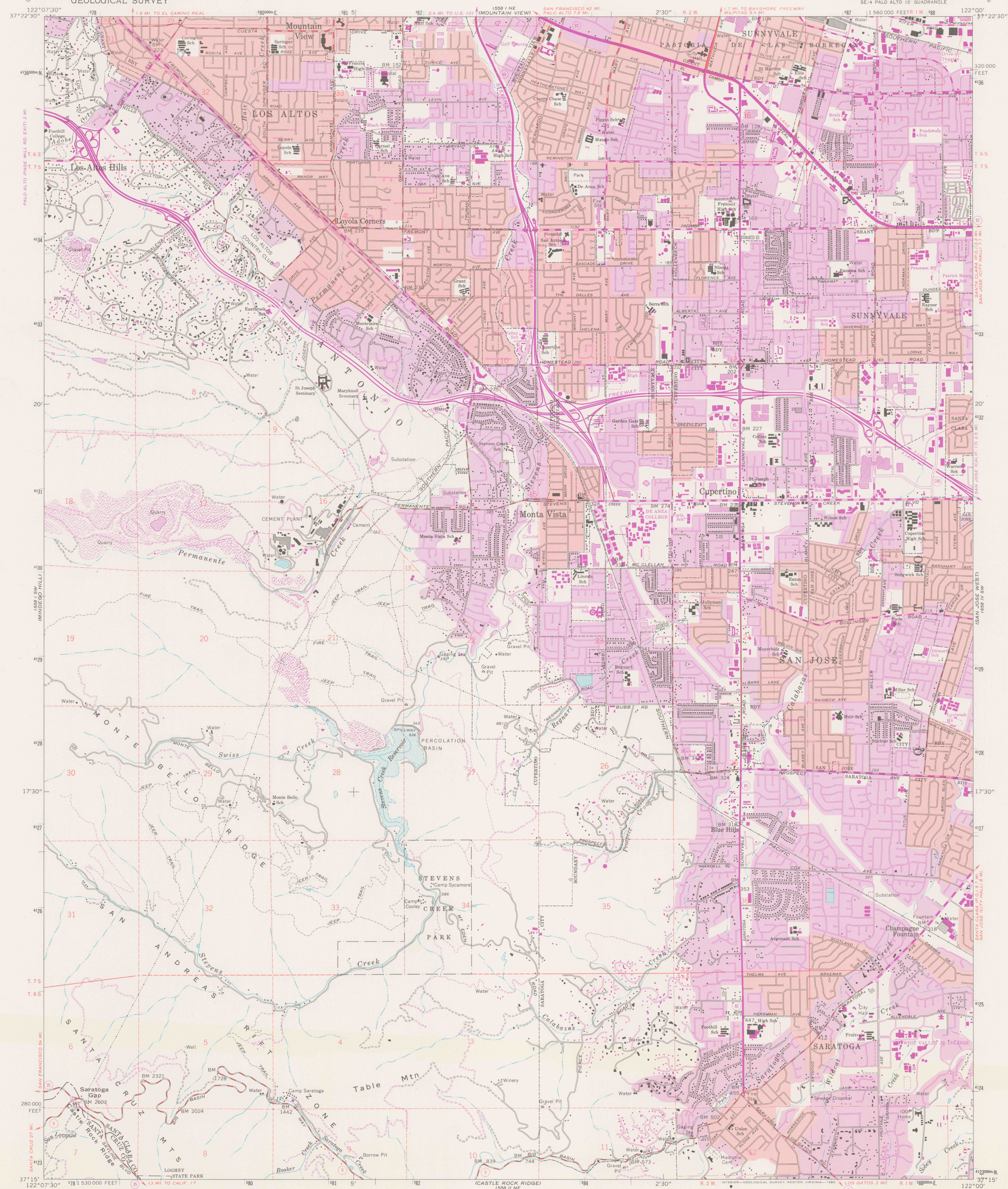


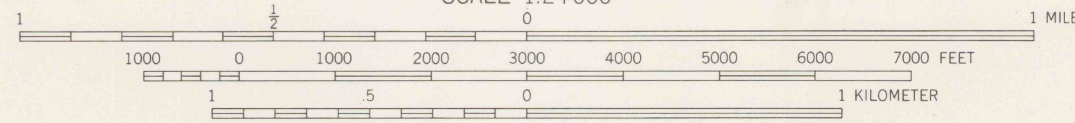

SE/4 PALO ALTO 15' QUADRANGLE

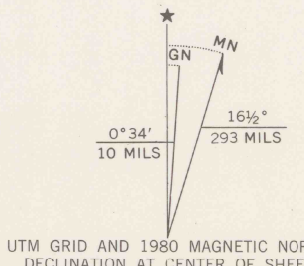

Polyconic projection. 10,000-foot grid based on California coordinate system, zone 3. 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 10, shown in blue. 1927 North American Datum. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 13 meters north and 95 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks. Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown. Dashed and lines indicate approximate locations. Land lines unsurveyed in parts of T. 8 S. - R. 2 W. A portion of this map lies within a subsidence area. Area covered by dashed light-blue pattern is subject to controlled inundation. There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map.
