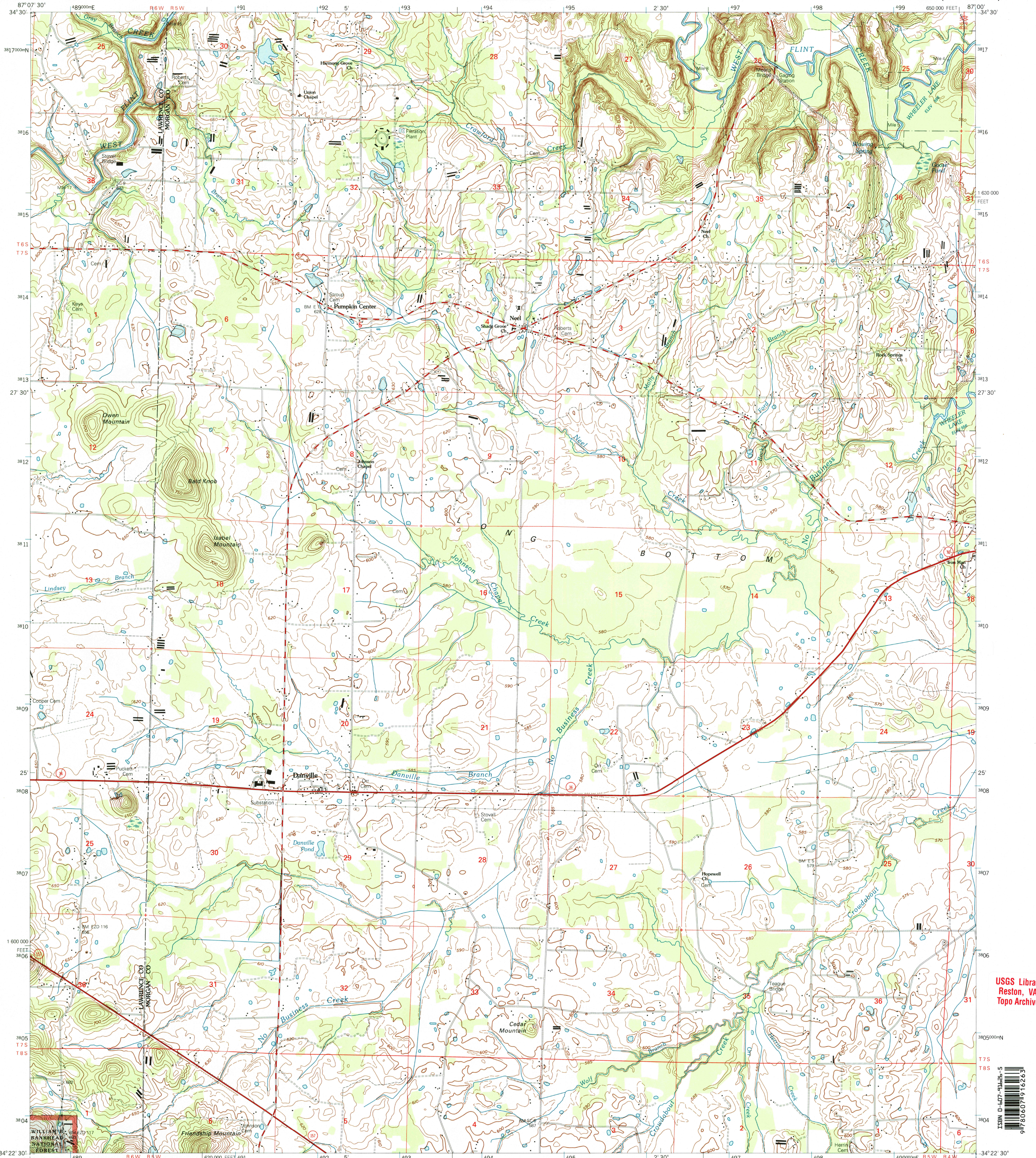

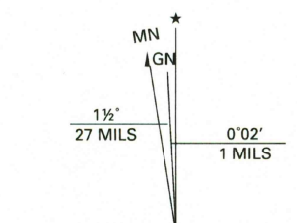

Blue 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator ticks, zone 16

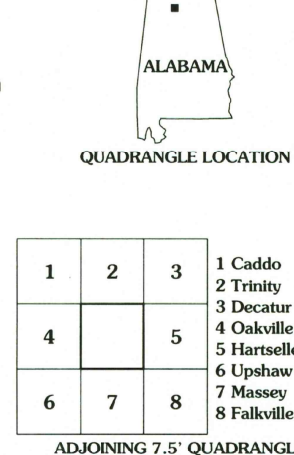
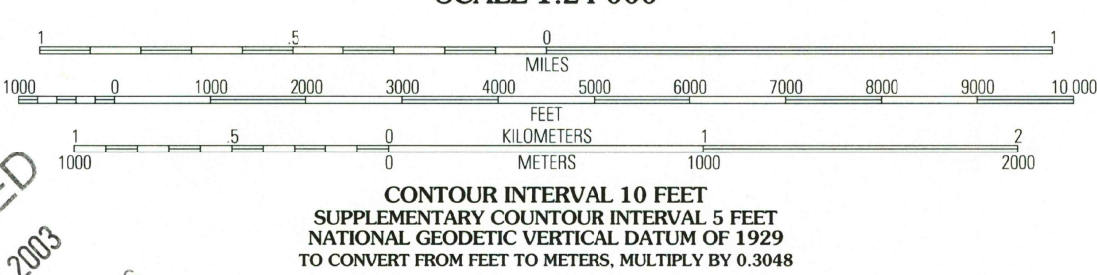
North American Datum of 1983 (NAD 83) is shown by dashed corner ticks
