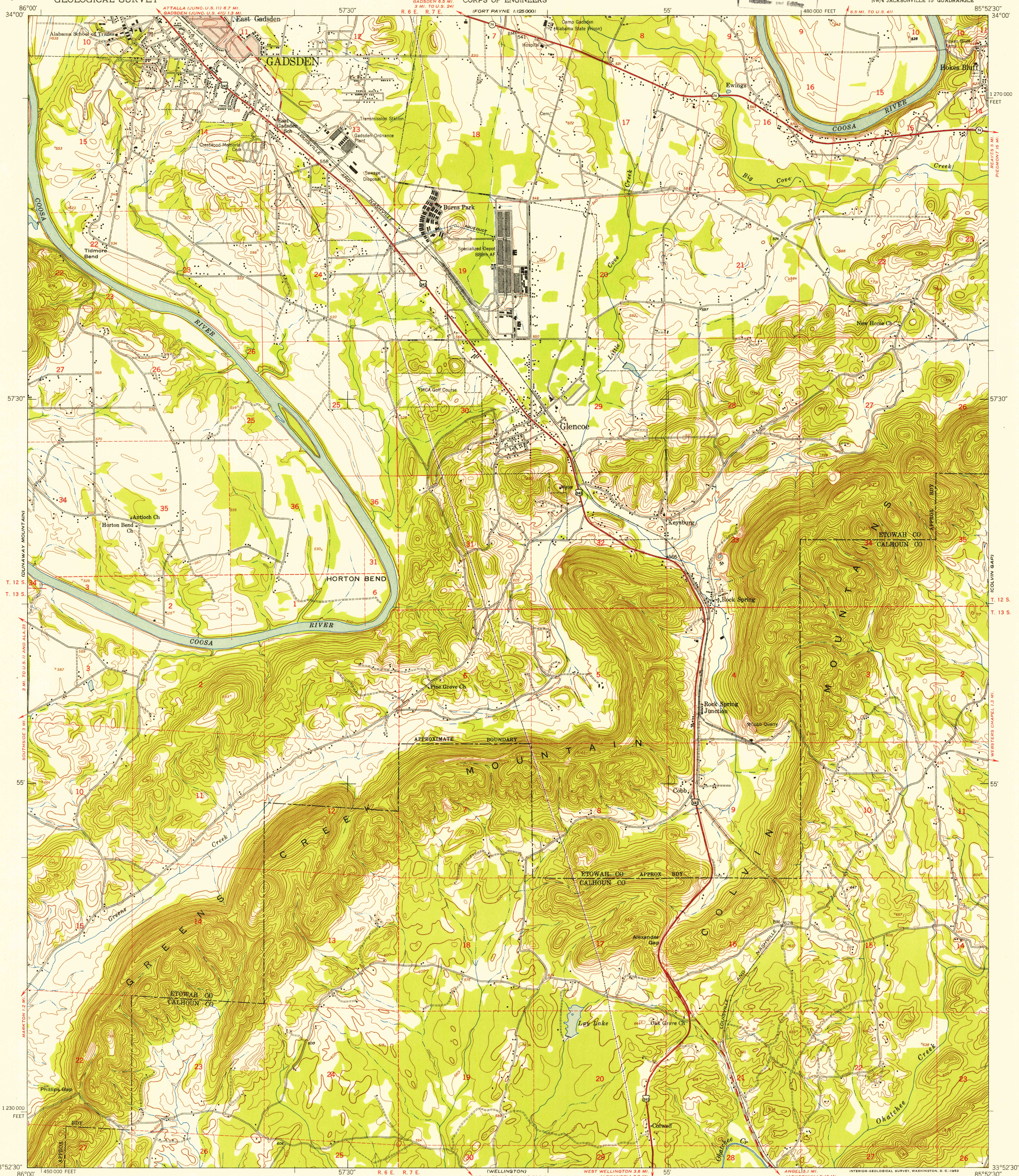

east zone

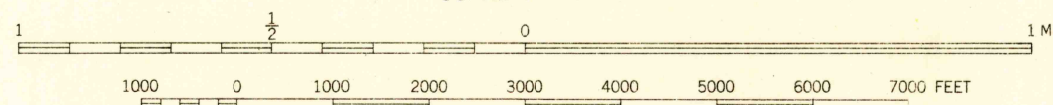
Red tint indicates area in which only
