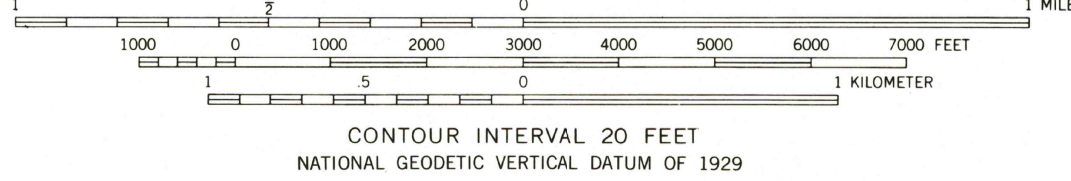
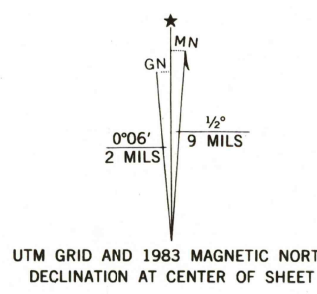

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 9 meters south as shown by dashed corner ticks.

This information not field checked. Map edited 1983

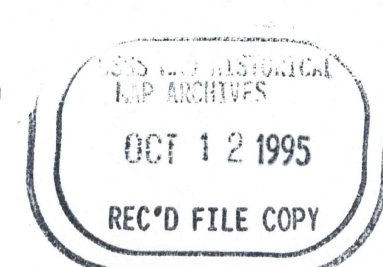
