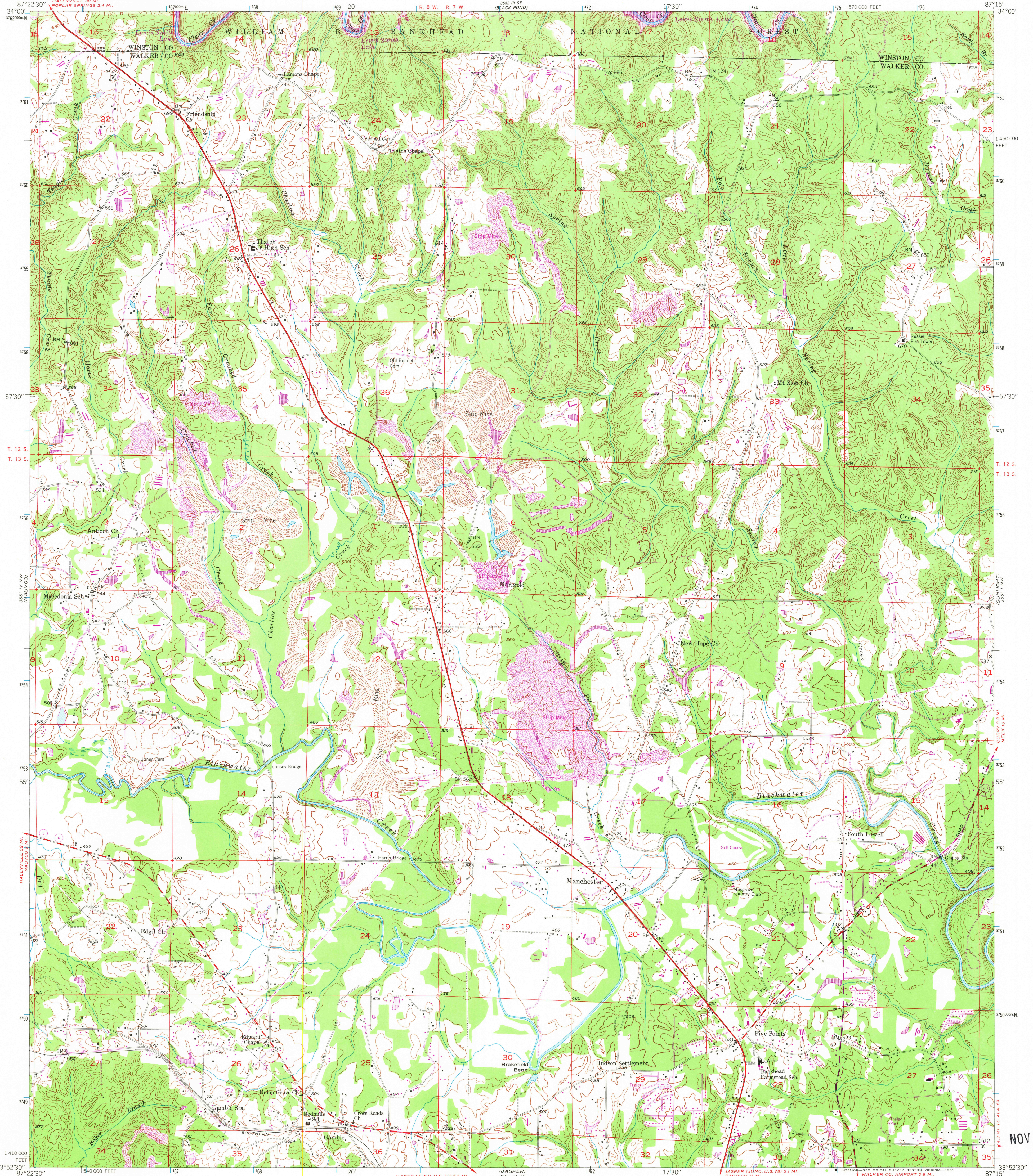

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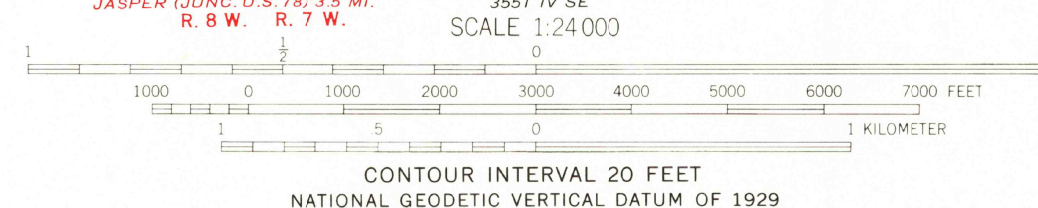
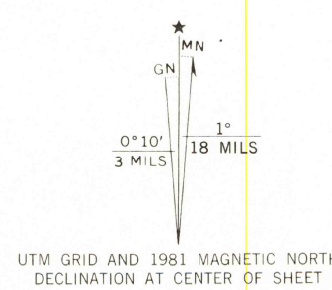
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Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1946. Field checked 1949

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 9 meters south as shown by dashed corner ticks
