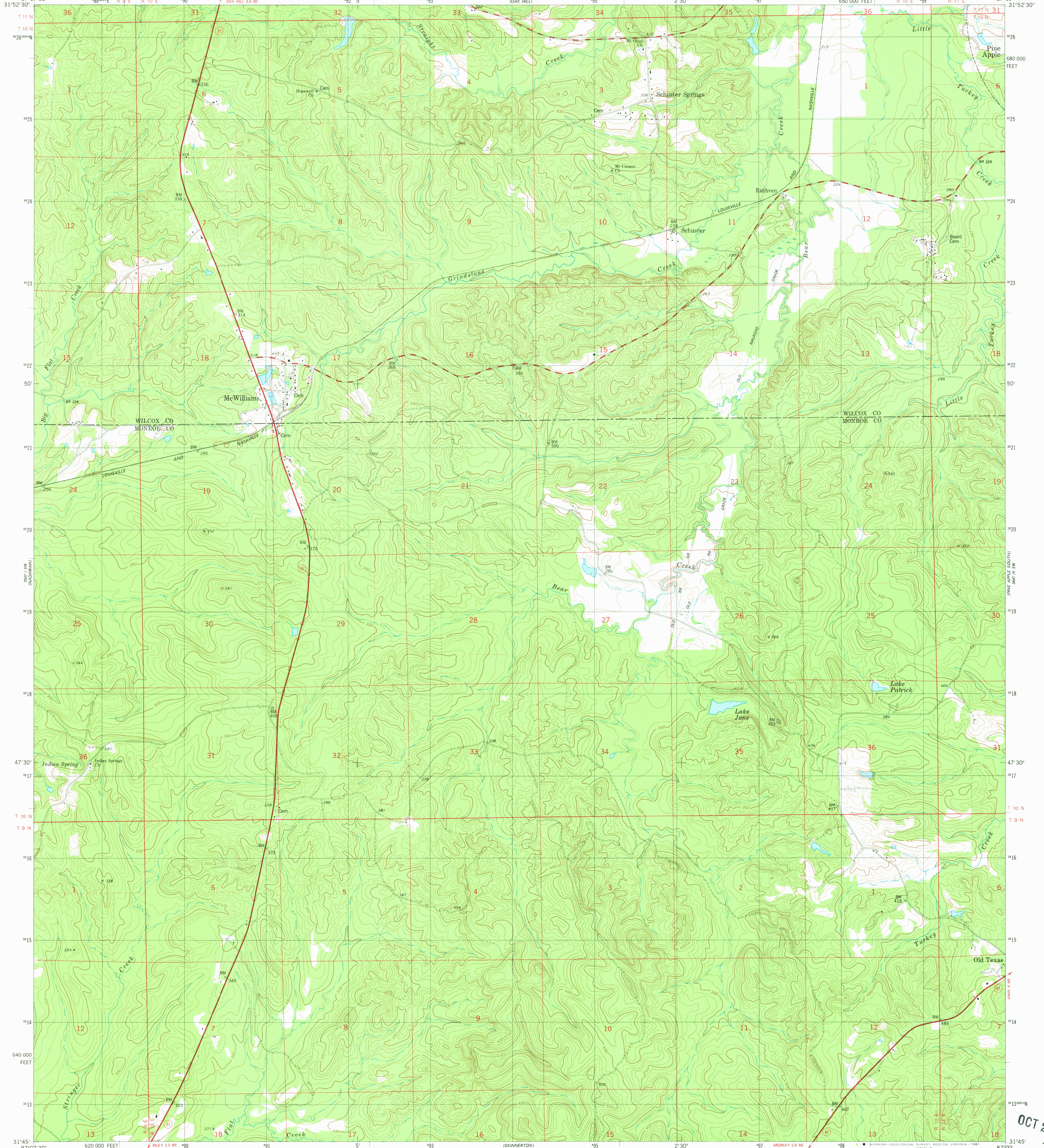

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 14 meters south and 2 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked
