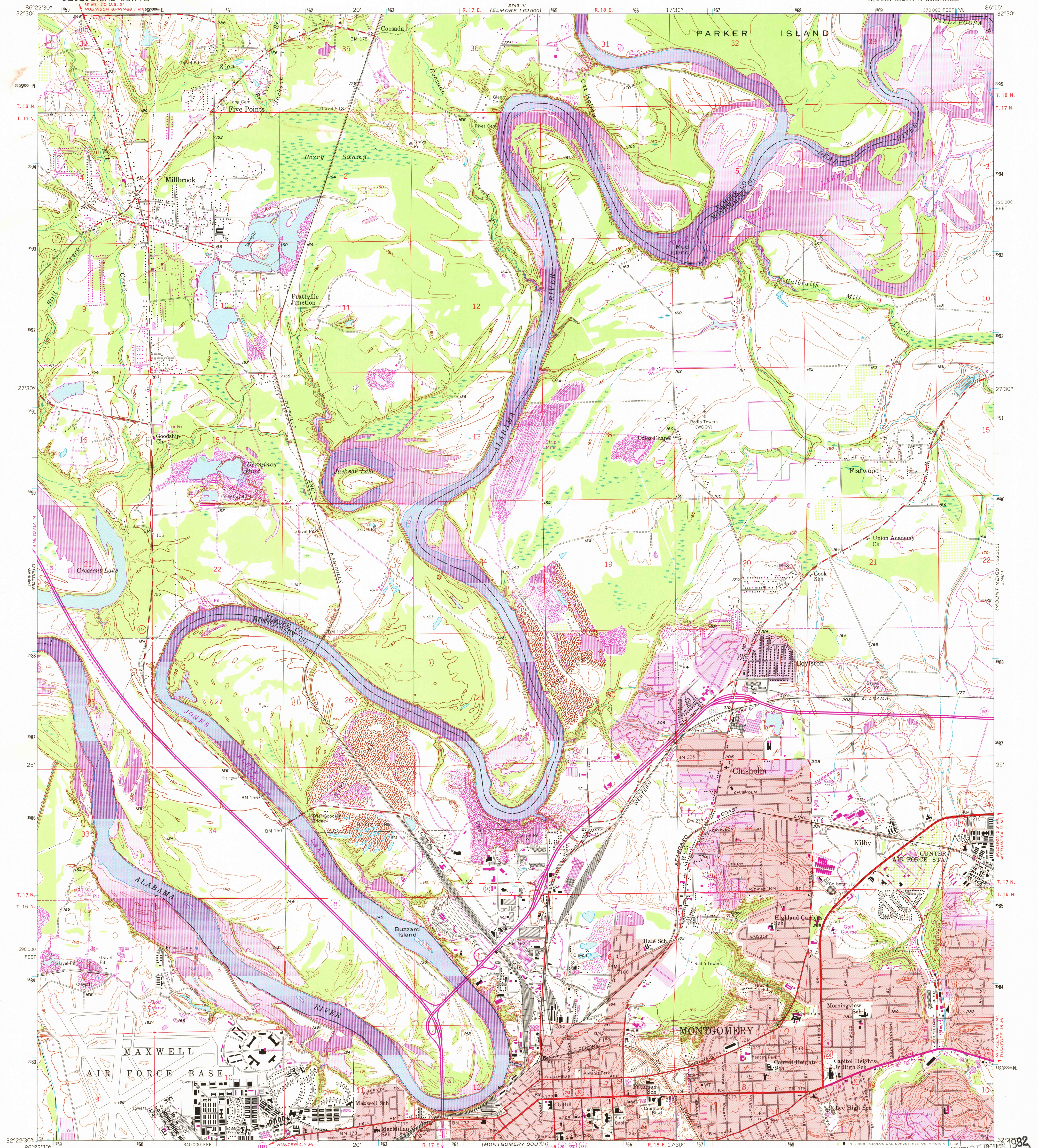

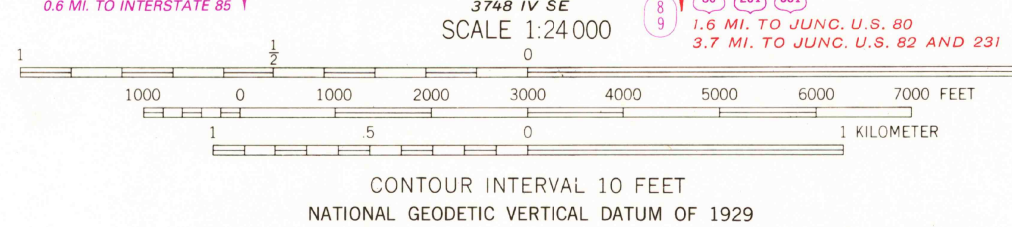
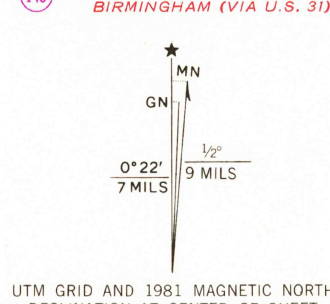
Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1955. Field checked 1958

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 12 meters south and 3 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks

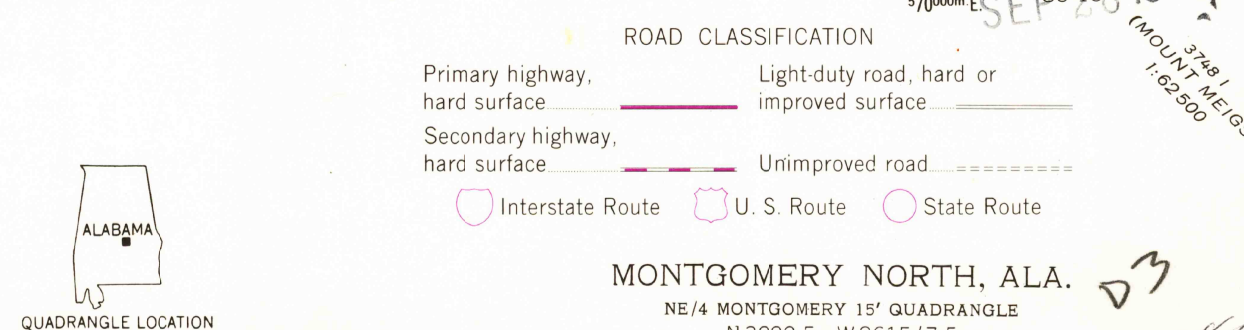
Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown. There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map
