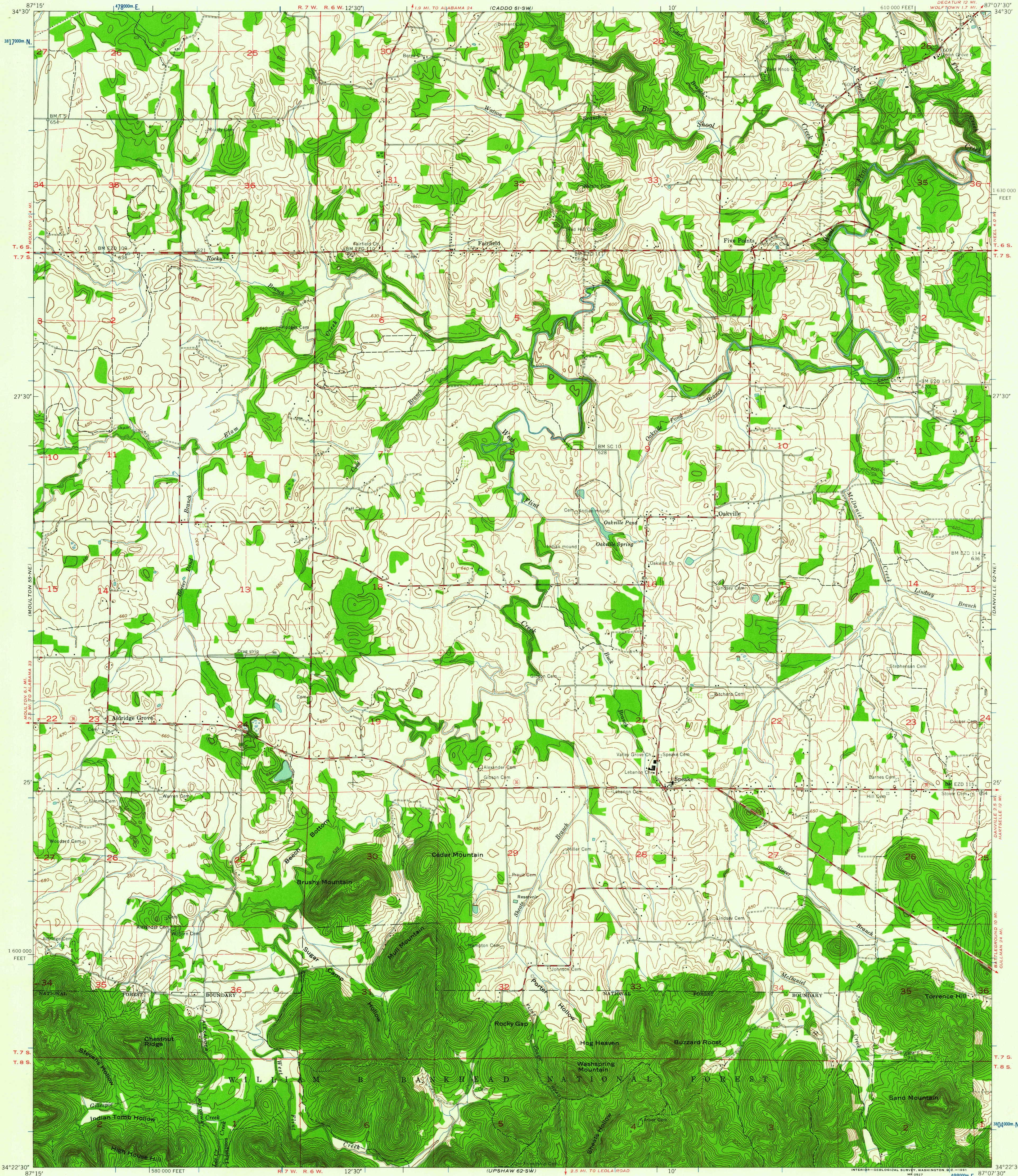

Zone 16, shown in blue

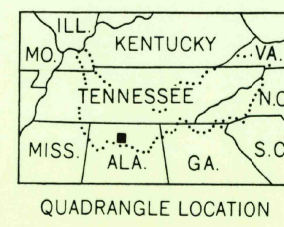
