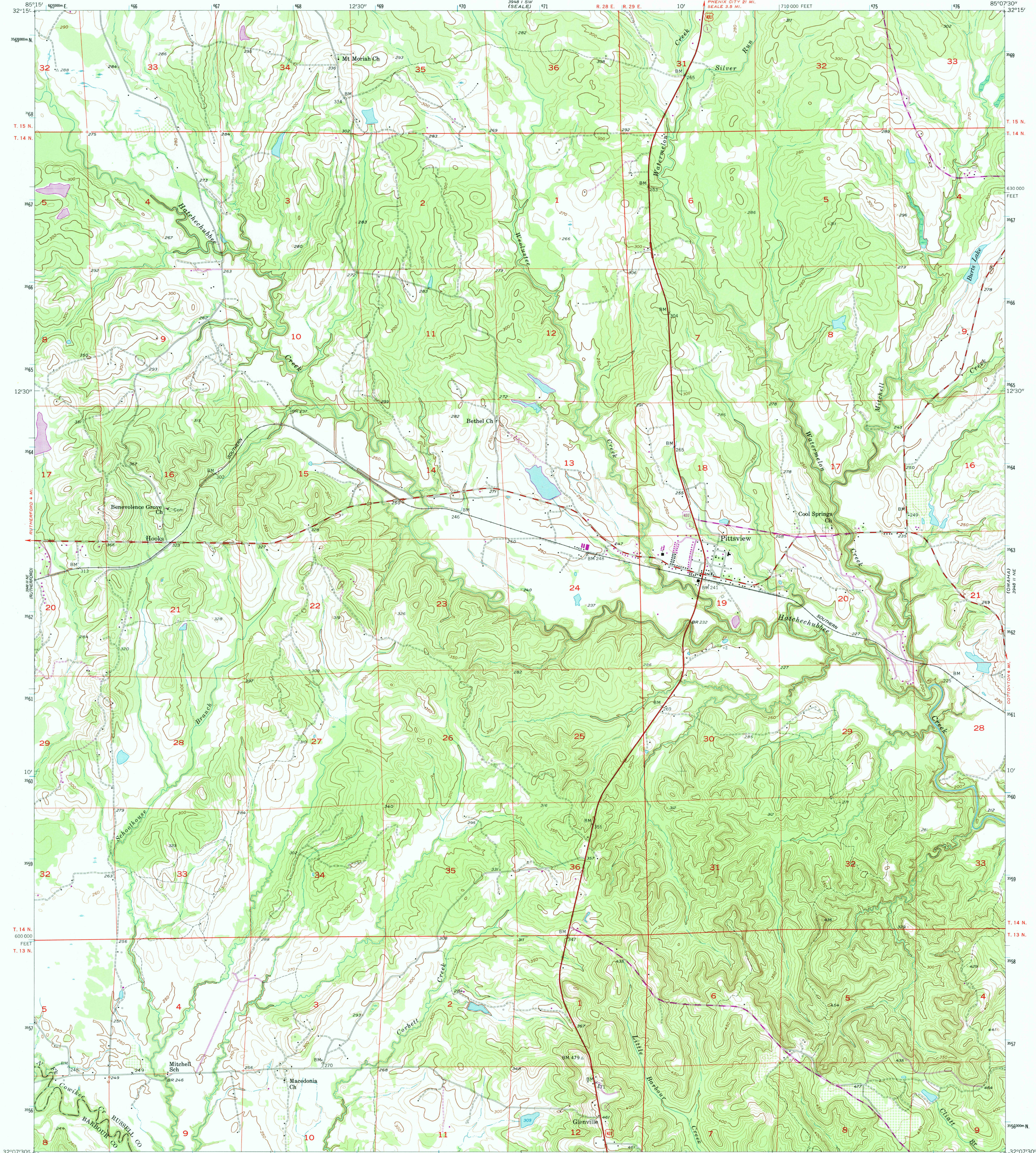


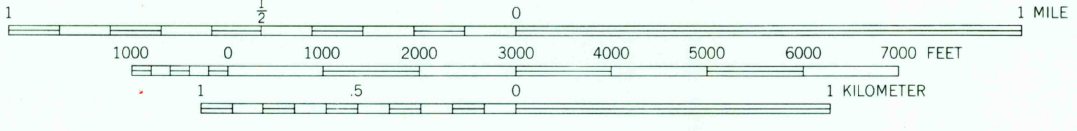
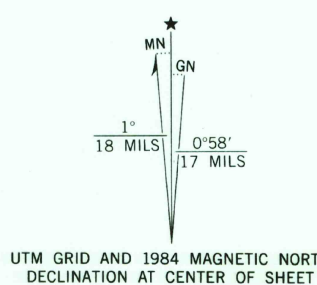

Polyconic projection. 10,000-foot grid ticks based on Alabama coordinate system, east zone
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 16, shown in blue
1927 North American Datum
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 13 meters south and 6 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks
Revisions shown in purple and woodland compiled from aerial photographs taken 1981 and other sources
