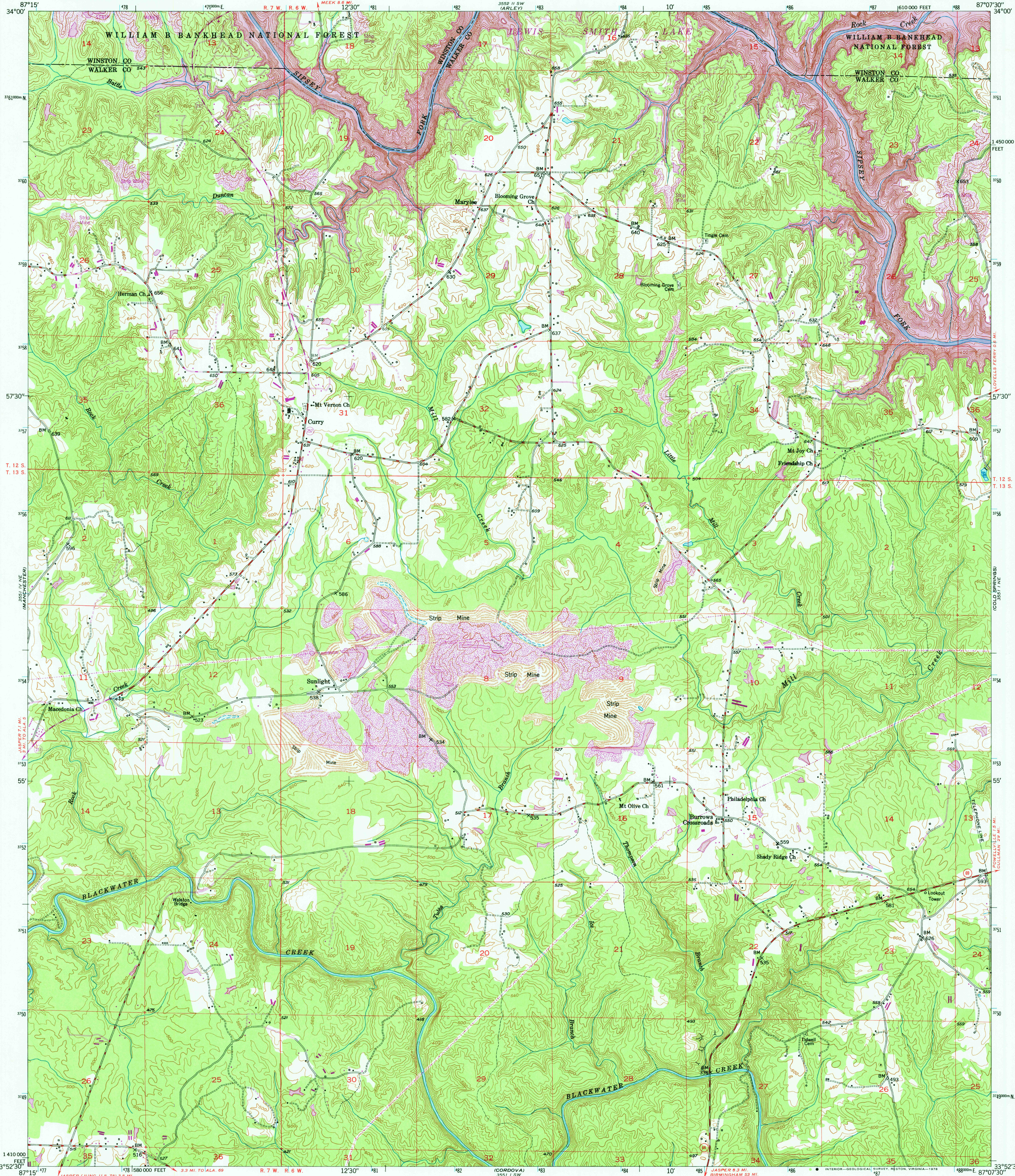

10,000-foot grid based on Alabama coordinate system

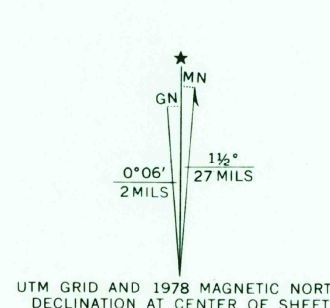
