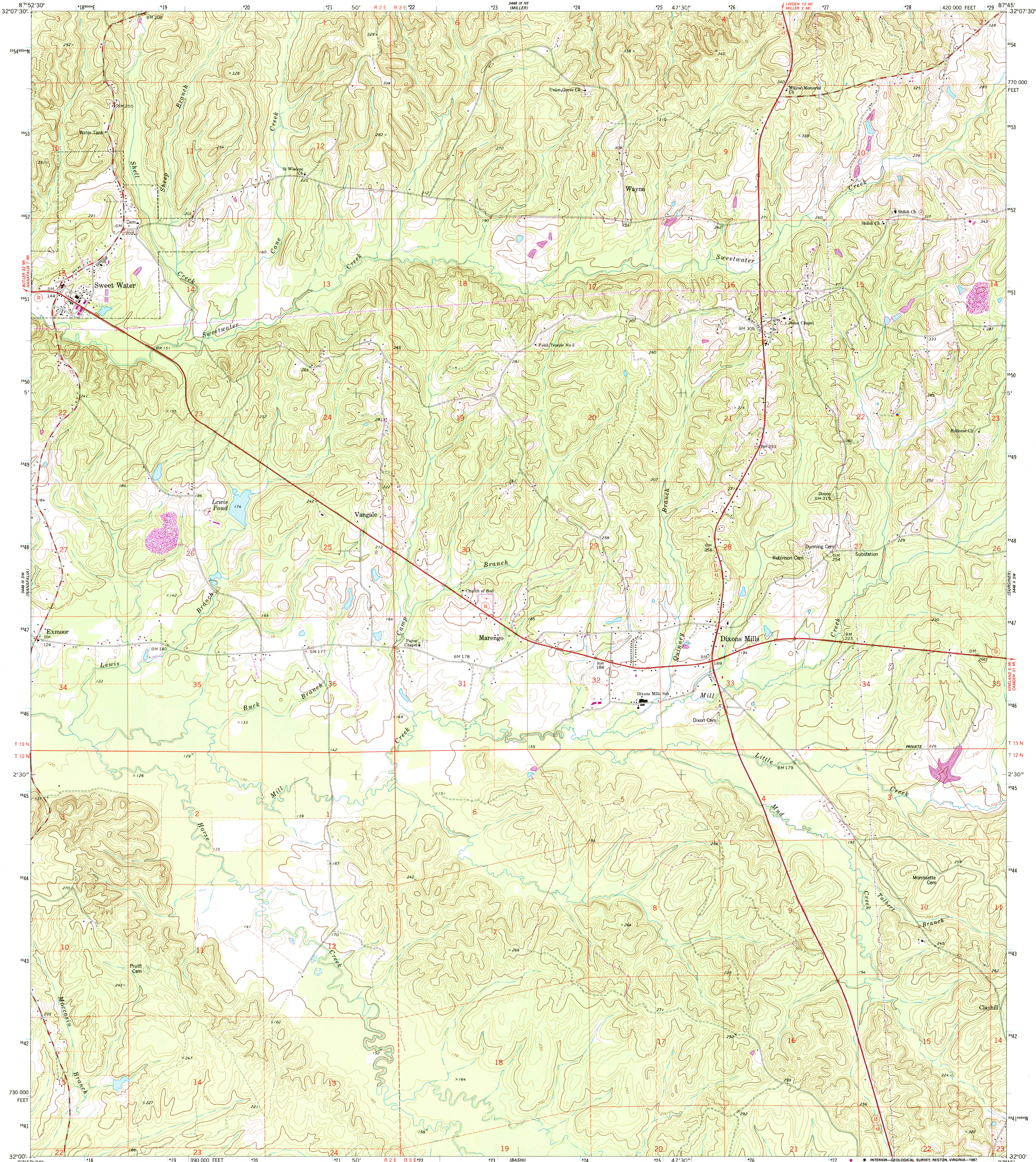

Projection and 10,000-foot grid ticks: Alabama coordinate system, west zone (transverse Mercator)

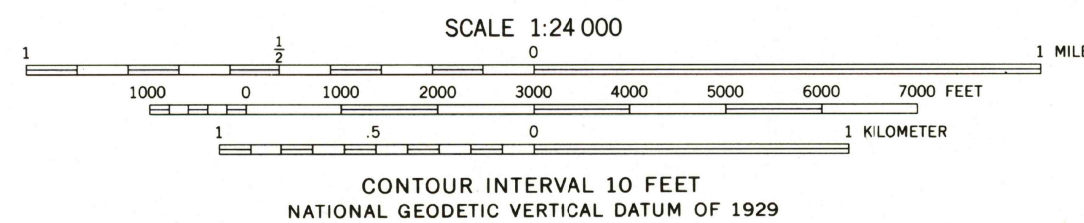
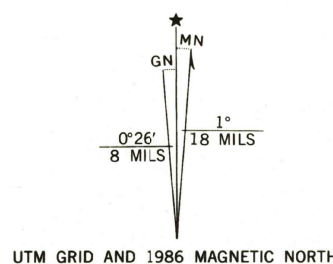
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 16, shown in blue

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked

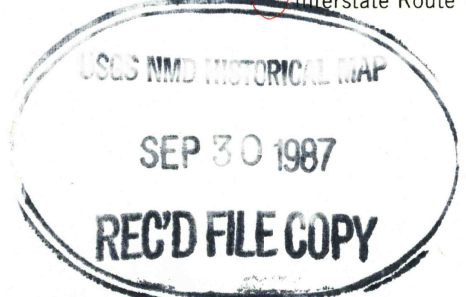
