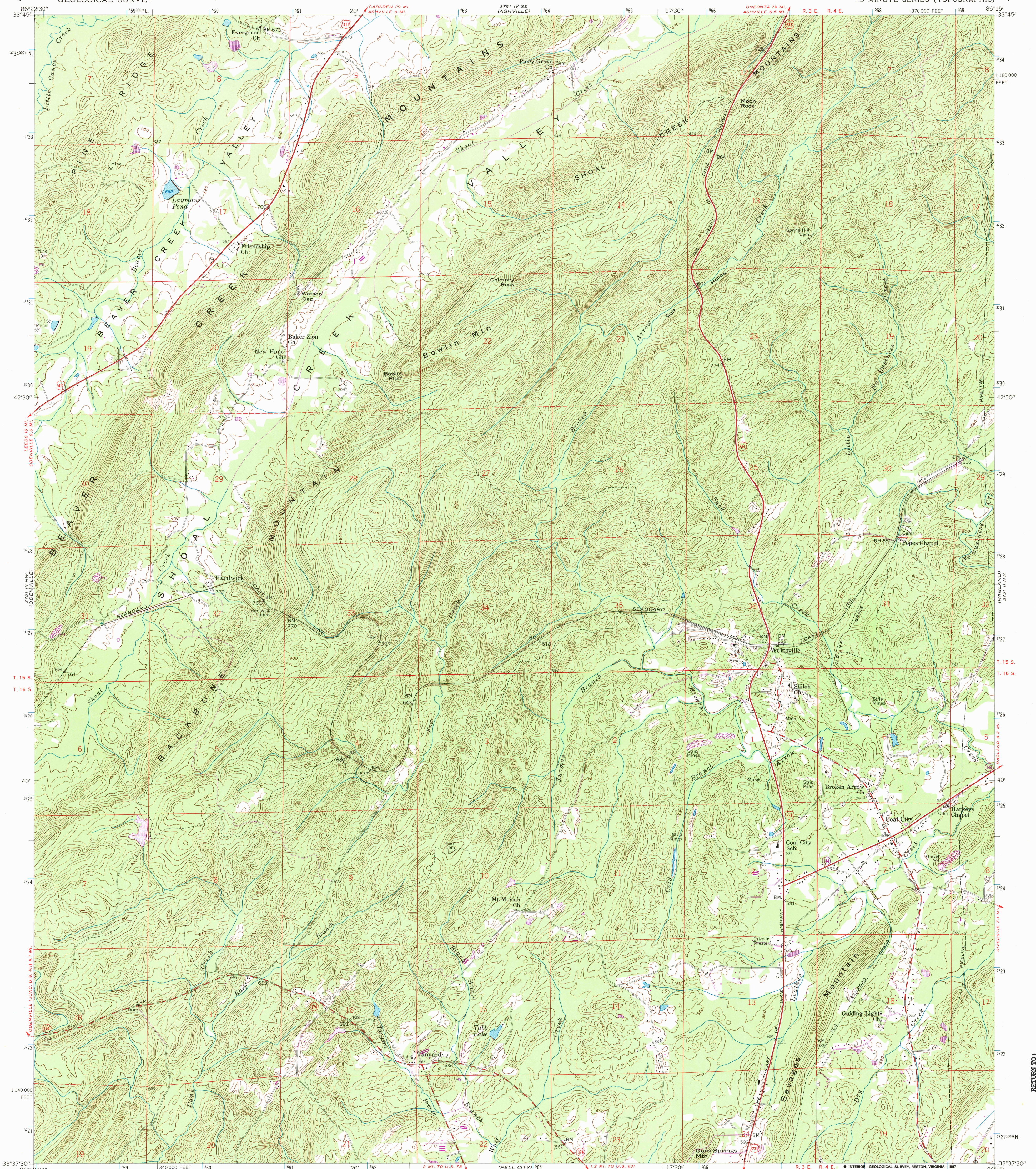

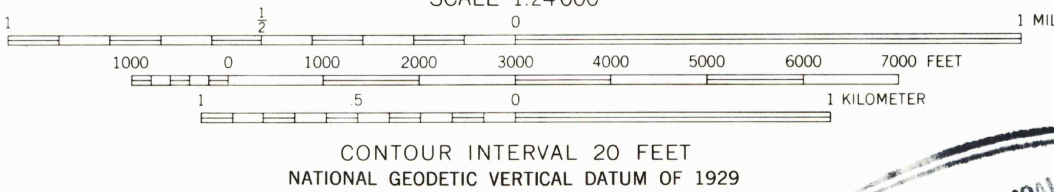
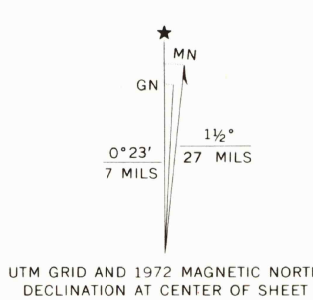

zone 16, shown in blue

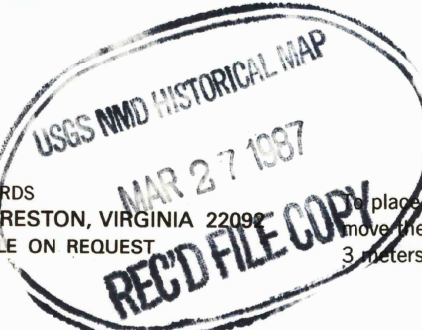
Unchecked elevations are shown in brown
