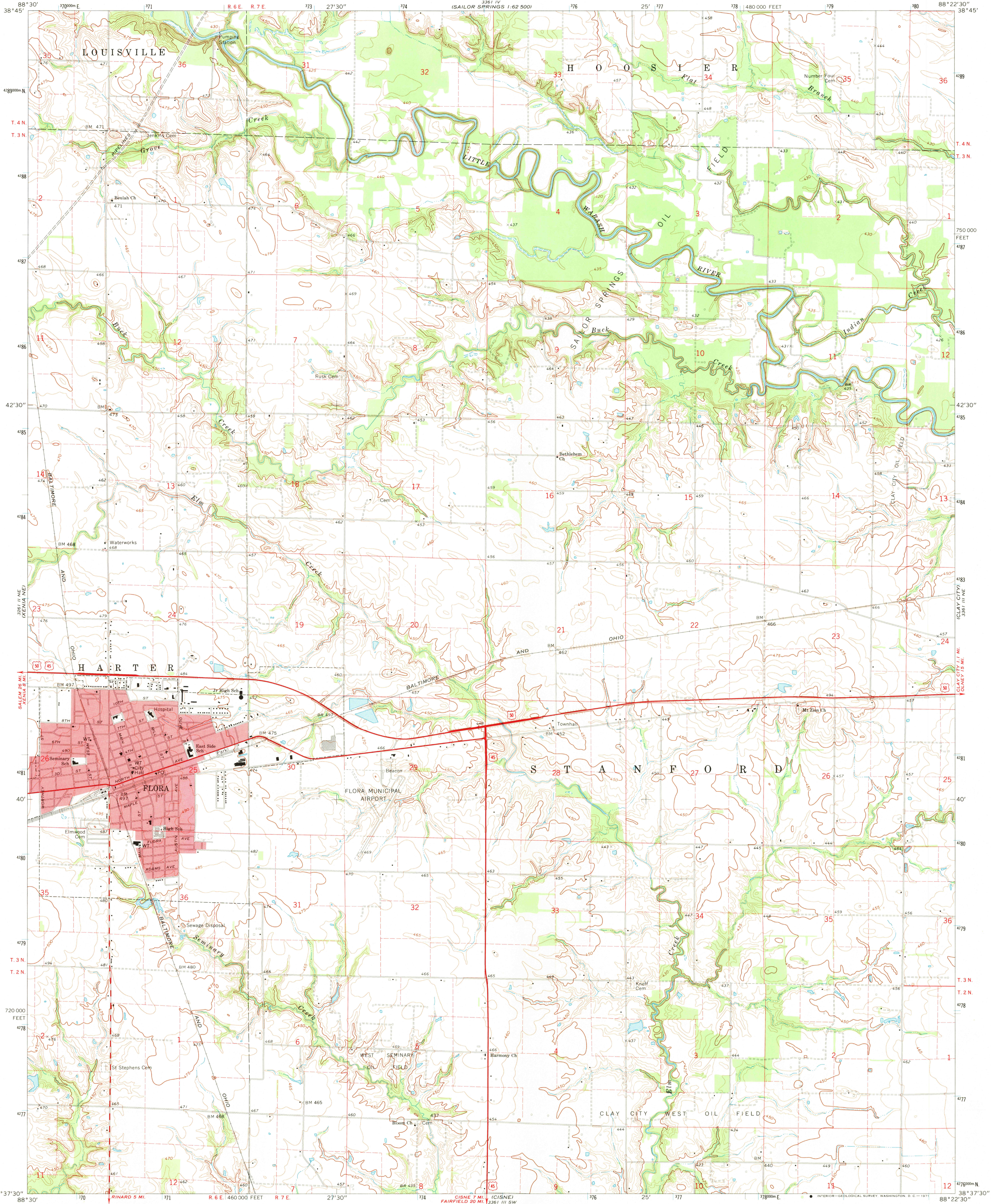

10,000-foot grid based on Illinois coordinate system, east zone

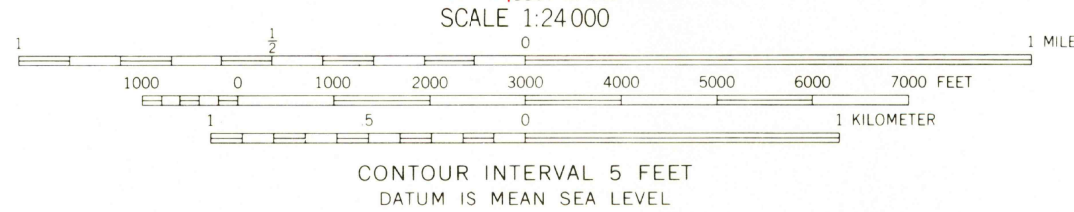
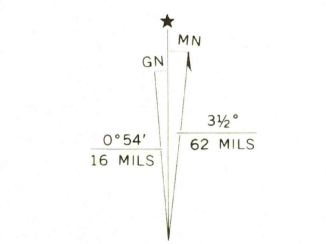
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,
