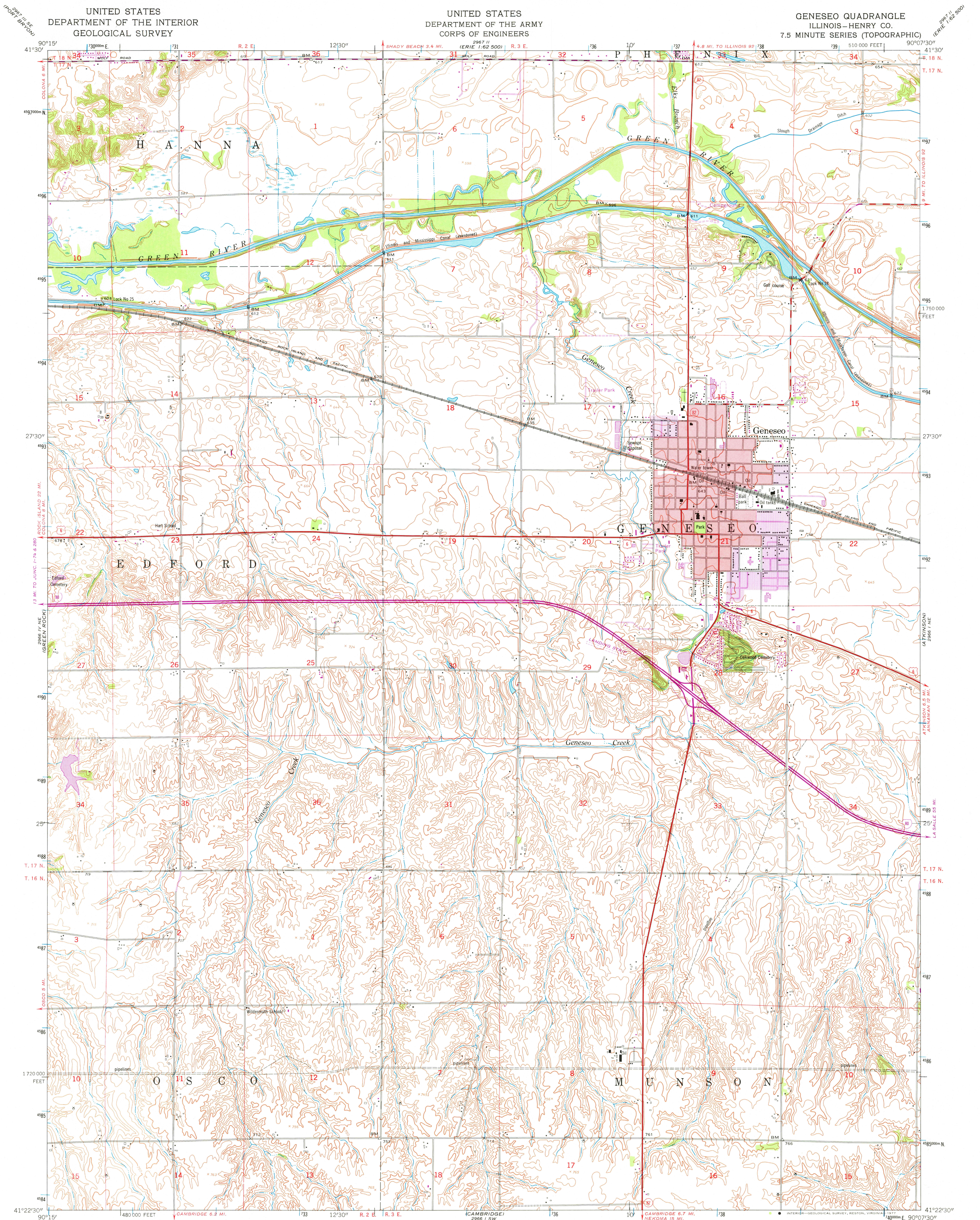

10,000-foot grid based on Illinois coordinate system, west zone

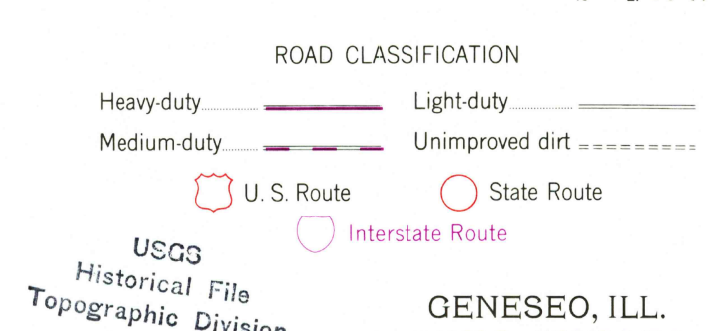
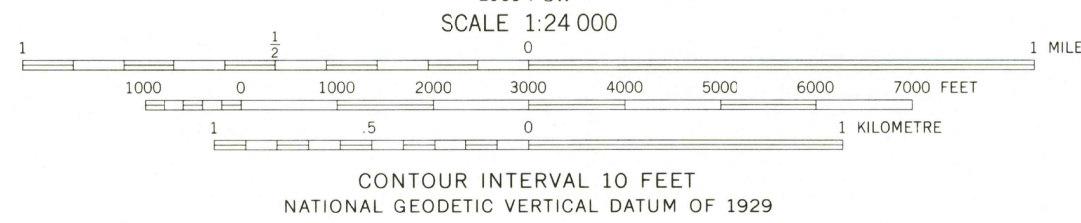
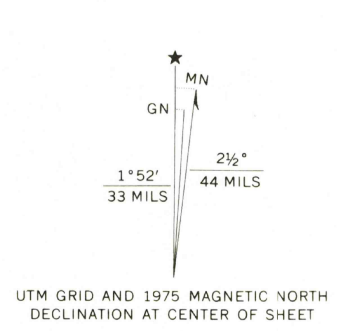
1000-metre Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,
