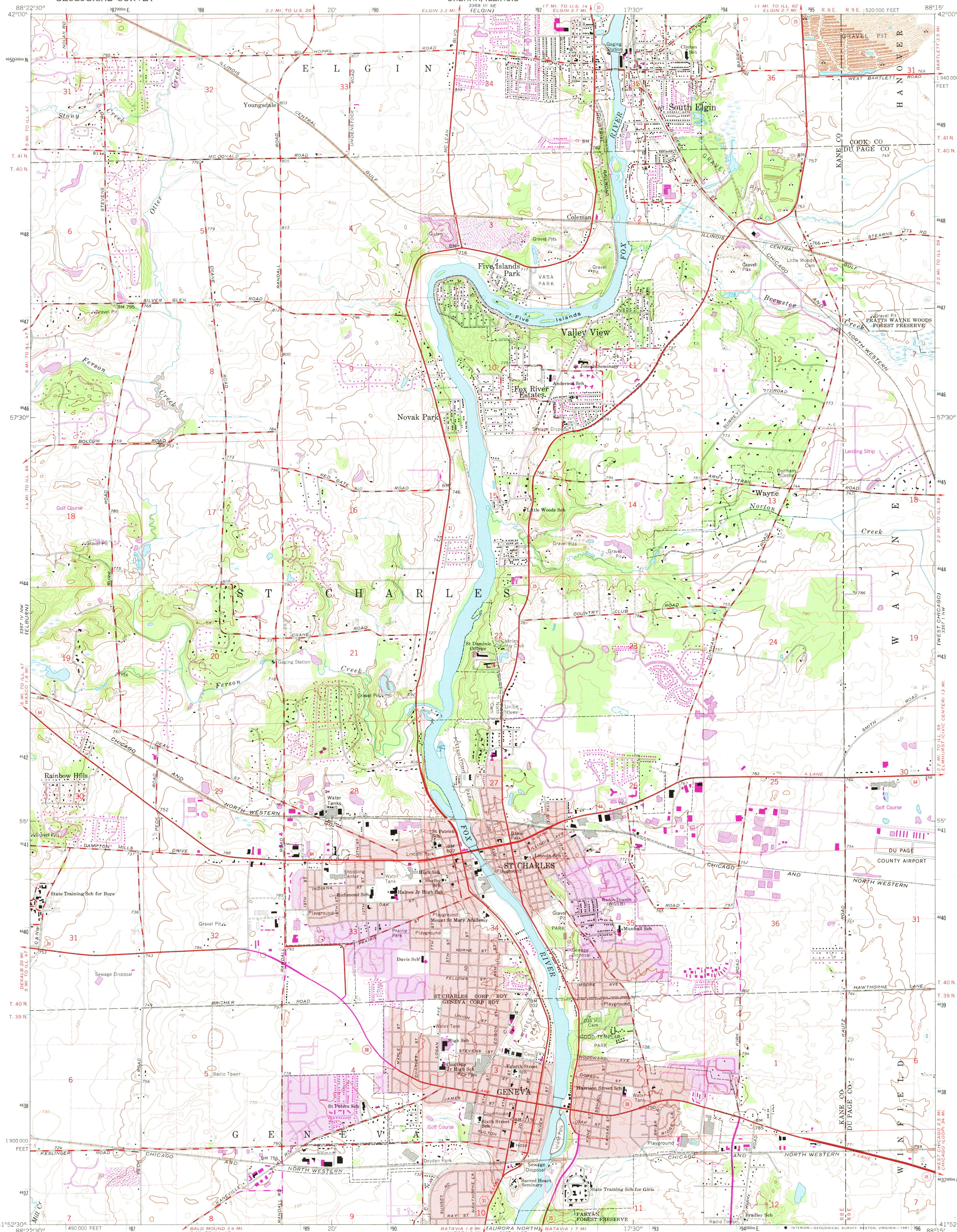

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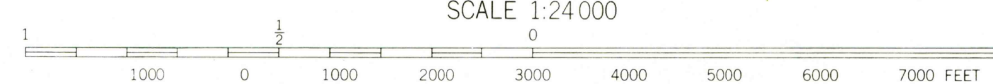
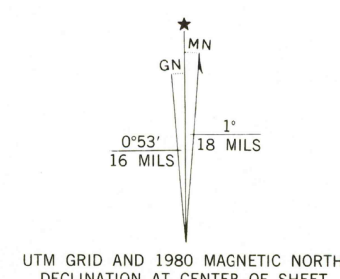
Planimetry by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1963. Topography by planimetric surveys 1947-48. Revised 1964

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grid based on Illinois coordinate system, east zone 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 16, shown in blue

Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 2 meters north and 6 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map
