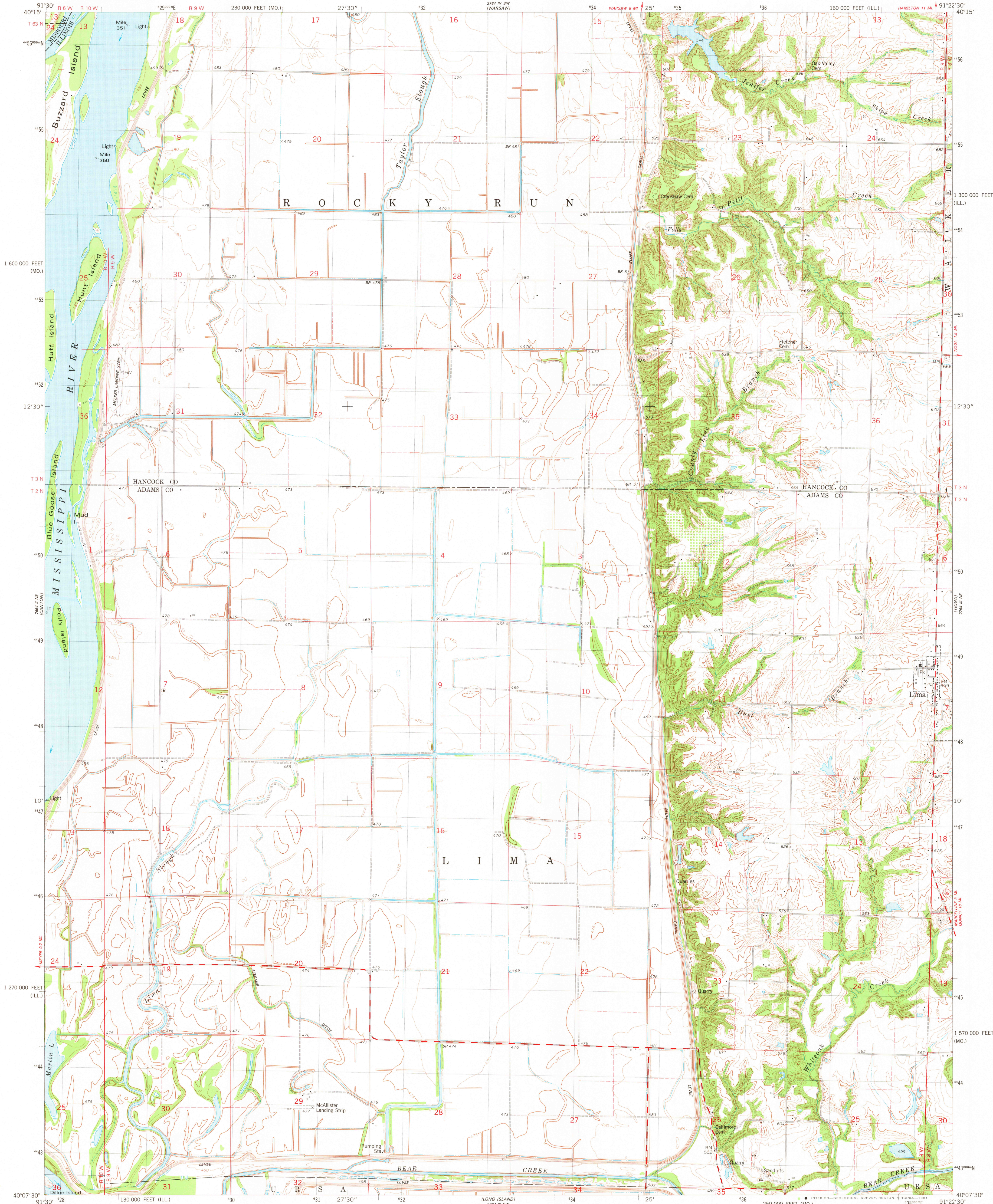

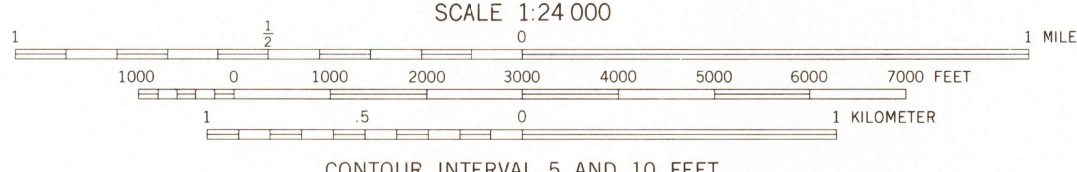
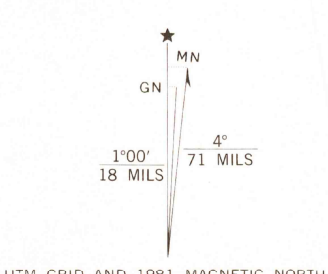

dashed corner ticks

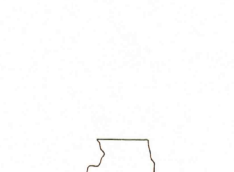
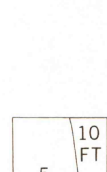
