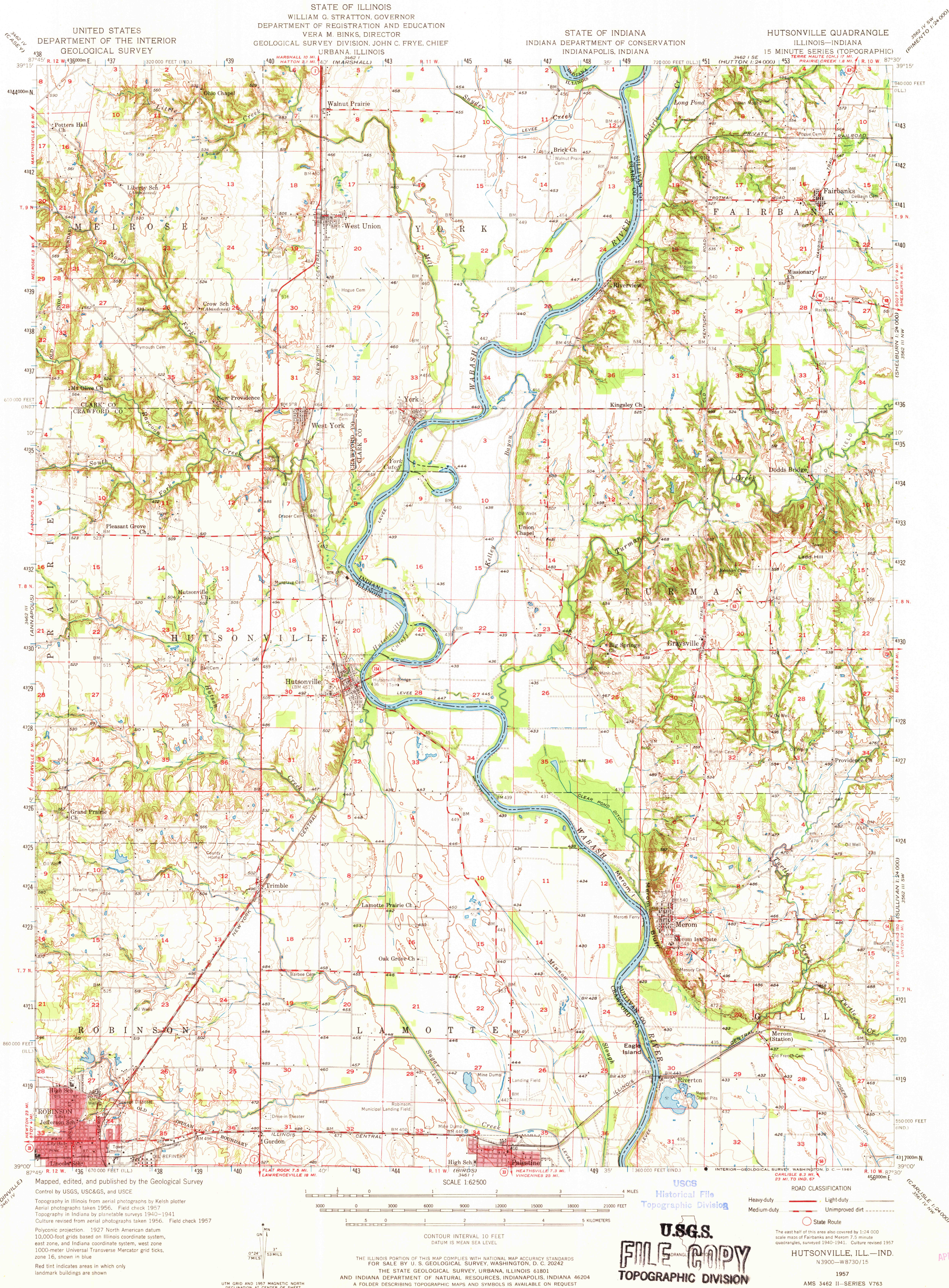


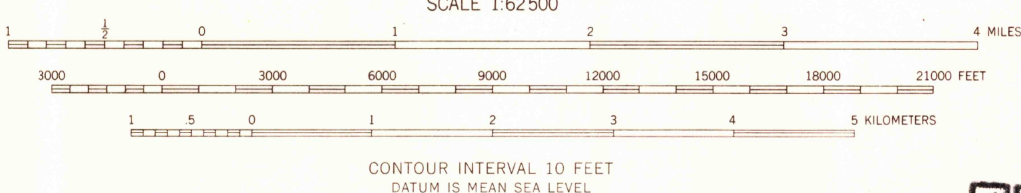


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Topography in Illinois from aerial photographs by Kelsh plotter
